2 BIG PICTURE WARNINGS

1 BIBLICAL WARNINGS ARE REAL

"In I here is a very real + present danger "drift from what you have heard "(2:1), "falling away from the living God" (3:12), "dull of hearing," (5:11), "unskilled in the WORD of righteousness" (5:13), "fallen away" (6:6), "Land bears thorns + thistles is worthless, and near being cursed, and its end is to be burned" (6:8), "sluggish" (6:12).

Take them seriously! Don't think you are above falling, beyond drifting... Tide "Therefore let anyone who thinks that he stands take heed lest he fall." I Cor. 10:12 Augustine's Parishioner

2 LET THE BIBLE DETERMINE YOUR THEOLOGY, NOT VICE VERSA

Example = "fallen away" (5:6) > can't be Christians b/c "once saved always saved."

Maybe, but let text inform your theology John Calvin

3 DETAIL WARNINGS

1 Beware of staying spiritually immature

== Hebrews 5:11-6:3

It Staying immature, like children ... you Need milk not solid food

Aturity powers of discernment trained by constant practice to distinguish good + evil.

Maturity > getting a solid foundation of Christian doctrine + practice.
6:1-2 "elementary doctrine of Christ."
