What is God's Holiness?

The separateness "otherness," brightness

"unapproachableness" of Θ 's total moral majesty

The weightiness of Θ ... What is its effect ↘

1. Human Lostness

☞☞ Woe is me! For I am lost; For I am a man of unclean lips, and I dwell in the midst of a people of unclean lips; for my eyes have seen the King, the LORD of hosts.

➔ When you stop comparing yourself to other people + start comparing yourself to Θ , you see your utter moral + spiritual lostness

2. Θ 's Atonement

"Then one of the seraphim flew to me, having in his hand a burning coal that he had taken with tongs from the altar. And he touched my mouth and said: 'Behold, this has touched your lips; your guilt is taken away, and your sins atoned for.'"

☑ How to be in Θ 's Holy Presence?
= Altar = By sacrificial atonement
Jesus, sacrificial Lamb, Isaiah 53

☑ Atonement has to be by Θ ! You can never clean yourself up enough.

ALL humanity lost **BUT**

ISAIAH'S PROPHETIC MINISTRY → ALL humanity provided a universal atonement sufficient for every person, to take away all sins, and cover your shame!

② WHAT THE HOLINESS OF Θ MEANS FOR YOUR CALLING


☞☞ Isaiah's lips purified, Θ's Question *Whom shall I send?* Isaiah's courage to offer himself *Here I am, send me*. Then LORD tells Isaiah that his ministry will be hard, barren, fruitless; Israel will remain unrepentant and disaster + desolation will come ► Your prophetic ministry Isaiah!

What kept Isaiah in the game?

What will keep you in the game, fulfilling your calling when it is hard?

Redmond Food Program Update – Kristin Muscott

In response to the pandemic, the Redmond Food Box program is continuing to deliver food at least monthly to families in need. We recently received an email from Peder Brakke that they could use delivery driver help. If you can assist in making deliveries, please email [Jim Gibons](#). Pray for this ministry and the families they serve. To prevent potential spread of germs, they are not taking food donations at this time, but if you would like to donate towards the purchase of food, Kristin started a [GoFundMe campaign](#).

Upcoming delivery dates: Saturdays, Nov. 21, and Dec. 19th. Drivers arrive at Redmond Presbyterian Church anytime between 10am – 3pm. Each driver will deliver to 3-5 families, usually within close proximity of one another, and will probably take about 2 hours. All deliveries are left on the doorsteps. We ask volunteers to text the families to let them know their box has arrived. Each food "box" is typically four pieces: two bankers boxes and 2 grocery bags, so cars with plenty of space work best.
