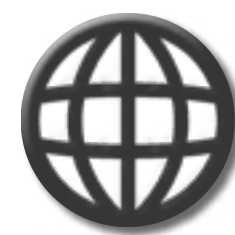

### Haggai 1-2:9

**1** In the second year of Darius the king, in the sixth month, on the first day of the month, the word of the Lord came by the hand of Haggai the prophet to Zerubbabel the son of Shealtiel, governor of Judah, and to Joshua the son of Jehozadak, the high priest:  
**2** “Thus says the Lord of hosts: These people say the time has not yet come to rebuild the house of the Lord.” **3** Then the word of the Lord came by the hand of Haggai the prophet, **4** “Is it a time for you yourselves to dwell in your paneled houses, while this house lies in ruins? **5** Now, therefore, thus says the Lord of hosts: Consider your ways. **6** You have sown much, and harvested little. You eat, but you never have enough; you drink, but you never have your fill. You clothe yourselves, but no one is warm. And he who earns wages does so to put them into a bag with holes.  
**7** “Thus says the Lord of hosts: Consider your ways. **8** Go up to the hills and bring wood and build the house, that I may take pleasure in it and that I may be glorified, says the Lord. **9** You looked for much, and behold, it came to little. And when you brought it home, I blew it away. Why? declares the Lord of hosts. Because of my house that lies in ruins, while each of you busies himself with his own house. **10** Therefore the heavens above you have withheld the dew, and the earth has withheld its produce. **11** And I have called for a drought on the land and the hills, on the grain, the new wine, the oil, on what the ground brings forth, on man and beast, and on all their labors.”

<sup>12</sup> Then Zerubbabel the son of Shealtiel, and Joshua the son of Jehozadak, the high priest, with all the remnant of the people, obeyed the voice of the Lord their God, and the words of Haggai the prophet, as the Lord their God had sent him. And the people feared the Lord. <sup>13</sup> Then Haggai, the messenger of the Lord, spoke to the people with the Lord's message, "I am with you, declares the Lord." <sup>14</sup> And the Lord stirred up the spirit of Zerubbabel the son of Shealtiel, governor of Judah, and the spirit of Joshua the son of Jehozadak, the high priest, and the spirit of all the remnant of the people. And they came and worked on the house of the Lord of hosts, their God, <sup>15</sup> on the twenty-fourth day of the month, in the sixth month, in the second year of Darius the king.

**2** In the seventh month, on the twenty-first day of the month, the word of the Lord came by the hand of Haggai the prophet: <sup>2</sup> "Speak now to Zerubbabel the son of Shealtiel, governor of Judah, and to Joshua the son of Jehozadak, the high priest, and to all the remnant of the people, and say, <sup>3</sup> 'Who is left among you who saw this house in its former glory? How do you see it now? Is it not as nothing in your eyes? <sup>4</sup> Yet now be strong, O Zerubbabel, declares the Lord. Be strong, O Joshua, son of Jehozadak, the high priest. Be strong, all you people of the land, declares the Lord. Work, for I am with you, declares the Lord of hosts, <sup>5</sup> according to the covenant that I made with you when you came out of Egypt. My Spirit remains in your midst. Fear not. <sup>6</sup> For thus says the Lord of hosts: Yet once more, in a little while, I will shake the heavens and the earth and the sea and the dry land. <sup>7</sup> And I will shake all nations, so that the treasures of all nations shall come in, and I will fill this house with glory, says the Lord of hosts. <sup>8</sup> The silver is mine, and the gold is mine, declares the Lord of hosts. <sup>9</sup> The latter glory of this house shall be greater than the former, says the Lord of hosts. And in this place I will give peace, declares the Lord of hosts.'"

*This is the Word of the Lord.*

### ① Consider Your Ways

☰☰ Post-exilic priorities Not yet time to rebuild the house of the LORD...

"Is it time for you to dwell in your paneled houses while this house lies in ruins?"

▶ Prioritizing personal households above  $\Theta$ 's house! Cf. vs. 9


➔ You and I prioritize our households above the church/household of  $\Theta$  ... right?

### WORD #1

Consider Your Ways vs. 5, 7 ▶  $\Theta$  withholds good things from his children until they prioritize the best! Parents w. Child,  $\Theta$  w. You?



## ② I am with You

 Then Zerubbabel ... Joshua ... with all the remnant of the people, obeyed the voice of the LORD their  $\Theta$   $\blacktriangleright$  Solution

In what way is this the solution? 2 Reasons

1. Their obedience out of the fear of the LORD vs. 17 overcame their root sin of fear 2:5 "Fear not"

"Get to the sin beneath the sin" Luther

See how fear motivated the prioritizing of their households over  $\Theta$ 's house?

2. Their obedience to the command of the LORD engaged the promise of the LORD

"I am with you 1:13 ... Work for I am with you" 2:4 The LORD stirred the spirit of Zerubbabel ... Joshua + the remnant of the people 1:14 ... My Spirit remains in your midst 2:5

**WORD # 2** I am w. You = Isn't this your deepest need + utmost security + strength?

**Cynical** Isn't this just a pastoral ploy to get people to prioritize the church, volunteer i.e. support you in your work? In other words this is subjective, your value not objectively valuable? Glad you asked



③ I will fill this house w. glory

☞☞ Context = Second temple was small + lacked glory compared to **this house in its former glory?** How do you see it now? Is it not as nothing in your eyes? 2:3

➡➡➡ Be strong... declares the LORD. Work...

1. The LORD promises to shake the nations ➤ treasures of all nations will come into this house ➤ Fulfilled in the Gospel of Jesus + Mission of his followers  
Growth of Church, objective fact



2. The LORD promises to make the latter glory of this house greater than former  
= The Church **Ephesians 2** > **Revelation**

**WORD # 3** I will fill this house w. glory  
Your work for + service to God's church has eternal worth + significance!
