Meaning of Scripture ? JESUS is the Listen to the Giants of the faith (2) The Motivation for Reading Scripture III My breakthrough "glory," vs. 41 - 44 Challenging passage, go thread by thread I do not receive glory from people

It Jesus does not accept glory from people It Jesus only seeks glory from O + to glorify O John 17:1-5 "The Father gets his major and most dependable glory, honor and attention when the Son he sent is glorified, honored and trusted," Bruner

But I know that you do not have the love of O within you. How does Jesus know this? I have come in my Father's name and you do Not receive me

I Jesus seeks O the Father's honor + glory I Jesus is so confident that he represents O that he can identify his own reception W. O's reception Jack Dorsey, Vintage Artist

If another comes in his own name, you will receive him = the way the world works, i.e. we receive/honor people based on their confident self-accreditation

Now Jesus hits the Nail on the head,

How can you believe, when you receive glory from one another and do not seek the glory that comes from the only God?

- 1. You are hard-wired by O to want praise, glory 2. Sin is stealing O's glory for self
- 3. Receiving glory from one another "is humanity's real god, the most ubiquitous idol of all." Bruner
- 4. Faith in Jesus as Son of O and Savior is the only way vainglory is crushed and O given all glory.
