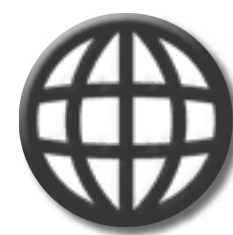

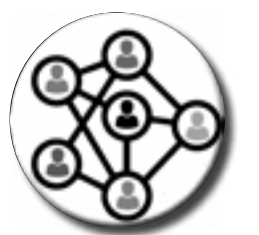

Scripture Reading

Zechariah 4:1-10

4 And the angel who talked with me came again and woke me, like a man who is awakened out of his sleep. ² And he said to me, "What do you see?" I said, "I see, and behold, a lampstand all of gold, with a bowl on the top of it, and seven lamps on it, with seven lips on each of the lamps that are on the top of it. ³ And there are two olive trees by it, one on the right of the bowl and the other on its left." ⁴ And I said to the angel who talked with me, "What are these, my lord?" ⁵ Then the angel who talked with me answered and said to me, "Do you not know what these are?" I said, "No, my lord." ⁶ Then he said to me, "This is the word of the Lord to Zerubbabel: Not by might, nor by power, but by my Spirit, says the Lord of hosts. ⁷ Who are you, O great mountain? Before Zerubbabel you shall become a plain. And he shall bring forward the top stone amid shouts of 'Grace, grace to it!'"

1. There is a situation

☑ Post-exilic Zerubbabel, governor; Joshua, high priest, Haggai, Malachi, Zechariah, prophets

☑ Jerusalem’s walls rebuilt but Temple destroyed

☑ People are indifferent, apathetic, discouraged “day of small things.”

☑ Not by [human] might, nor by power
