
Personal Ethic, Personal Holiness "Put to death therefore whatever is earthly in you" 3:=

# WHAT?

Thesis The roots of the SIN Nature go deep into the soil of who we are as humans regardless of age, race, gender, culture, economic; status, intertwining w. all we are and vandalizing and even destroying community.



The sinful roots must be uprooted, destroyed, "Mortified"... "Put to death therefore what is earthly in you" (3:5) and replaced with a whole New self (3:9)... after the image of its creator > Christ, the image/icon of  $\theta$  and Creator (1:15-16)

Personal Holiness [Christlikeness] is the only path to the Beautiful Community

The ORDER OF COLOSSIANS

- 1. Jesus, Son of O, is CREATOR and Redeemer, Reconciler "For in him all the fullness of God was pleased to dwell, and through him to reconcile to himself all things ... making peace by the blood of his cross." 1:15
- 2. Jesus Christ makes you holy by T

  "And you, who once were alienated and hostike in mind, doing evil deeds, he has now reconciled in his body of flesh by his death in order to present you holy and blameless and abover reproach before him." 1:21-22

- Jesus Christ canceled the debt of your sin by his death on the cross

  "And you who were dead in your trespasses and the uncircumcision of your flesh, God made alive together with him, having forgiver us all our trespasses, by canceling the record of debt that stood against us with its legal demands. This he set aside, nailing it to the cross." 2113-14
- 4. You are safe "eternally secure," hid in Christ in God (3:3) and destined for glory "When Christ who is your life appears, then you will appear whim in glory." (3:4)
