Discussion Questions

1. Last week Pastor Joel invited us to pursue the depth, length, height and breadth of God's love for us. What have you learned and/or experienced of God's love this past week? Did it surprise you? How have you let that knowledge and experience make you different this past week? Share and discuss with your life group
2. Today's sermon was really taking this truth to the next step. Pastor Joel mentioned in the beginning of his sermon that spiritual giftedness and spiritual maturity are not the same thing. Have you personally experienced a person with fantastic spiritual gifts who was very immature spiritually? What did that look like and how did it impact you? Have you experienced a person who has little knowledge of spiritual gifts and yet demonstrated spiritual maturity? What did that look like and what is your take away?
3. It is not uncommon for us to want to do something great for God even if it is in a relatively "small venue". What would you see happening to you if you had the "spiritual giftedness and empowerment" to do something great but without the needed amount of spiritual maturity? What would be the experience of those around you if that happened at Cornerstone with its leaders?
4. As a life group take the time to pray encouraging prayers for each member as they share how they are learning and experiencing God's love for them and how they are then trying to turn around and share that love with others.
