Back to School: Reminding Ourselves of Who We Are and Why We Are Here

Week 2: Practical Gospel

Introduction: The Christian faith changed the world. In its original context, the early church was considered to be led by people who turned the world upside down. (Acts 17:6) The upside-down turn happened because the first followers of Jesus lived in such a way that their faith in Jesus made a tangible impact in the world around them. Slaves, women, children, foreigners, lepers, the abused, the outcast, and the lesser valued person all found solid ground at the Cross of Jesus. Although social status continued to divide people, faith in Jesus brought the rich and the poor, the master and the slave, the oppressor and the oppressed together in peace.

This world-changing faith is what practical gospel is all about. The practical gospel can be expressed quite simply as good news for everyday life!

Today, we have so compartmentalized our faith. We go to church—rather than living as the church. We schedule programs rather than entering into relationships. In short, we have, at the expense of those around us, contained the world changing power of the good news.

It's time to live in power and grace again. It is time for Cornerstone to embrace a full-bodied gospel that makes real world differences. As James declares, "faith that doesn't work is dead!" James 2:14-17
