Digging Deeper

Find ways to be more aware of how God watches over you this week. Open your eyes to the spirit realm around you. See people in the same way God sees them. Pray for God to fill you with grace, compassion, patience and love for others.

When is the last time you have cried for God? If you are in a desperate situation right now, humble yourself and pour your heart out to God. Give the spirit time to chip away at your callous heart. It could take several minutes, if not more than an hour, to have a breakthrough with God that leaves you feeling refreshed.
