

Queen Elizabeth I Reigned for 45 years (1558-1603)




The Spanish Armada (1588)




17th Century Separatist Distinctions: Church Government Structure

17th Century Separatist Distinctions: Confessional Documents

Confessional Documents (Statements of Faith Documents)

- Westminster Confession (1647): Presbyterians
- Savoy Declaration (1658): Congregationalists
- 2nd London Baptist Confession (1677): Particular Baptists
- Standard Confession (1660): General Baptists


