Our Boeing South Carolina (BSC) Manufacturing Student Development Programs allow current students and recent graduates of hands-on courses at high schools and Community & Technical Colleges to gain manufacturing experience through a paid, on-site, hands-on training experience.

- All programs require students to have foundational skills in the use of tools and safety in a shop environment. Students in hands-on courses such as automotive, construction, fabrication, manufacturing, robotics, metals and others are encouraged to apply.
- Students will be employed by a third-party staffing company and assigned as contractors to Boeing, paid \$17.50 per hour.
- Selected students enrolled at schools or colleges more than 55 miles from site will be considered by the staffing company for a 'Distance Bonus' to help compensate for arrangements to attend work. The Bonus amount will be benchmarked against local temporary housing costs and advised to eligible participants with offer.
- Work will be split between Boeing's North Charleston site and Trident Technical College. Participants must provide their own transportation to their assigned work location each day.

FOR HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS AND RECENT GRADS - 1st shift

Over 6 weeks, students will learn either mechanical assembly, electrical installation or industrial paint skills, along with blueprint reading, precision measurement, Lean principles and other critical advanced manufacturing skills.
