
Names for Northern Tribes of Israel

- God Renamed Jacob "Israel"
- Israel's sons are the Tribes of Israel
- After the division of the nation, the Northern Kingdom (10) were often referred to as "Israel" and the Southern (2) "Judah"
- There is no "Joseph" Tribe
 - He is given a double portion through his sons, Ephraim and Manasseh, both part of the Northern Kingdom



Fulfillment of Zech 9:1-8

 Destruction of Tyre by Alexander the Great on 332 BC (vs 3-4) - <u>FULFILLED</u>



Fulfillment of Zech 9:1-8

- Destruction of Tyre by Alexander the Great on 332 BC (vs 3-4) - FULFILLED
- Gentiles are fellow heirs of the Kingdom of Heaven (vs 7) BEING FULFILLED
- God himself will dwell with them, end of all oppression and war (vs 8) – TO BE FULFILLED

Fulfillment of Zech 9:9-10

- Jesus Triumphal Entry <u>FULFILLED</u>
 - King coming humbly
 - Righteous bringing salvation

Matthew 21:1-5

Now when they drew near to Jerusalem and came to Bethphage, to the Mount of Olives, then Jesus sent two disciples, saying to them, "Go into the village in front of you, and immediately you will find a donkey tied, and a colt with her. Untie them and bring them to me. If anyone says anything to you, you shall say, 'The Lord needs them,' and he will send them at once." This took place to fulfill what was spoken by the prophet, saying,

"Say to the daughter of Zion,

'Behold, your king is coming to you, humble, and mounted on a donkey, on a colt, the foal of a beast of burden."

Fulfillment of Zech 9:9-10

- Jesus Triumphal Entry <u>FULFILLED</u>
 - King coming humbly
 - Righteous bringing salvation
 - A King performing Priestly Duty!!!
- Jesus Returning as King to RULE the NATIONS!! – <u>TO BE FULFILLED</u>

Fulfillment of Zech 9:11-13

- WHY?? "Blood of my covenant with you"
 - MOSAIC Exodus 24:8 Moses to the Israelites at Mt Sanai
 - NEW Matthew 26:28 Jesus to the disciples in the upper room (see Hebrews 9)

Fulfillment of Zech 9:11-13

- Hopeful prisoners set free from "Waterless Pit"
 - NEAR TERM Waterless Pit = Metaphor for Lifeless (2 Pet 2:17, Jude 1:12)
 - Judah's defeat of Antiochus Epiphanes in 167 BC
 - ULTIMATE Waterless Pit = place of the dead (Luke 11:24, Mattew 12:43)
 - Resurrection of the Dead
 - Defeat of Antichrist at the battle of Armageddon

Fulfillment of Zech 9:14-17

- The LORD "Appear" "Lightning" "Trumpet Sound"
 - Exodus 19 Mt Sanai
 - 1 Thessalonians 4 The Resurrection from the dead at the return of Christ
- The LORD will go before them and they shall be victorious in battle
- The bowl of his wrath shall be drunk to the dregs (Rev 14, 19)
- God will save his people on that day
- They shall continue in splendor and prosperity
