We just finished eleven Perspectives classes in the Northwest. It's a blessing to see how these classes impact students and lead people into lifelong ministry. We have six classes this coming fall, including two intensives for pastors. Fall is always our smaller semester, so we are using this time for a major upgrade to our website. In our Better English ministry, we finished our classes for the school year and saw great growth in our students – including students in our new Basic English program who went from being painfully shy to making jokes in class. We are now in our summer routine with weekly Walk & Talks and field trips. The break from weekly classes and meetings also affords the opportunity to invest more deeply in relationships with various international friends. This summer we are also busy traveling, speaking at churches, mission's conferences, and doing leadership training events.
