

MISSION IN FOCUS: Aaron & Jully Bullock, The Passion Center, Malawi

We recently returned from a three-week family trip to Malawi, where we served in vocational school devotionals, VBS, and college ministry. One of the greatest joys was watching our boys experience a new culture and quickly connect with people, naturally joining in ministry alongside us. During VBS, we gathered with 200-300 children and were encouraged to see many respond to the gospel. We also spent time in the vocational school and college ministry—areas that will be our primary focus when we relocate in August for full-time mission work at the Passion Center in Zomba.

This trip gave us a clearer picture of life and ministry ahead, and we were deeply impacted by the love, joy, and hospitality we experienced.



Malawi Children's Book Drive

We are sending supply drums to Malawi to support our churches and ministries and hope to start village reading clubs to promote literacy (English is the testing language) and share Christ. IMPACT THROUGH SERVING

Serving in ministry has become something deeply personal to me. At one point, I made a simple prayer asking God to use me as an instrument of His will and His peace, and to help me be a light in a world that can feel dark at times. I didn't fully know what that would look like, but I wanted to be available.



For me, a lot of that has taken shape through serving in the choir. What started as just singing has become something more meaningful. It's a way to worship, to encourage others, and to be part of something that brings people closer to God.

I've come to understand that serving isn't about having all the answers or being perfect. It's about showing up, being present, and trusting that God can work through even the smallest moments. In doing so, I've grown not just in my faith, but in how I care for others.

One of the most meaningful parts of this journey has been seeing the impact extend beyond myself. Serving in ministry has shown me that being willing matters more than being ready, and that even in life's challenges, God can still use us for something good.
