This Monday evening, April 22, millions of Jewish families, communities, and individuals will gather for Passover. During this biblically-appointed time, we pray for the peace/Shalom of Jerusalem, and the salvation of Israel as we gather at the Table of the Lamb—Yeshua. In Him, we have sure healing and redemption.

As we break unleavened bread for seven days, may the eyes of Israel be opened like the disciples who encountered Jesus on the way to Emmaus. As we drink from the fruit of the vine, may our hope be placed in Yeshua, our Messiah, "The Lamb who takes away the sin of the world!" (John 1:29)

As we prepare for Passover, there is a growing threat from many of Israel's enemies, including Iran. Despite an increasingly dangerous world for our people, we have great hope! The same God who heard our cry in Egypt is the same God who hears our cry today. We stand firm on our Abba's promises to Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob (Gen. 12:2-3).

Happy Passover, Lake City Community Church! Thank you for loving God and others so well. Thank you for praying for the protection and salvation of Israel, Lake City, and all peoples of the world—including our enemies. We are reminded of Yeshua's words on the cross as The Passover Lamb:

"And Jesus said, 'Father, forgive them, for they know not what they do.'" (Luke 23:34)
