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MISSION IN FOCUS: Jordan and Chelsey Faker, Basque Country, Spain

We are missionaries to the Basque People, an unreached people group with less than .67% having heard the gospel. We continue to respect the culture, serve the city, and follow the Spirit by becoming part of the community. We learn the language, join and serve in events, and build deep friendships to open hearts to the gospel. We recently had a team here who helped us have a 4th of July picnic, join a city festival, and importantly have many good conversations about God.



We also received a huge answer to prayers after 3½ years as Chelsey and I were finally approved for residency. This is a huge weight lifted off our shoulders that also opens many doors and opportunities. We can now work toward raising finances for a van and opening a culture center that will allow us to have a space to serve by practicing English, connecting in a natural setting, and ultimately speaking with people about their need for Jesus.

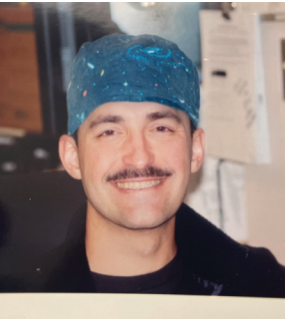

I would certainly identify myself as a "New Believer." This past winter, I felt like I needed more direction in strengthening my walk with the Lord. I had heard about Every Man a Warrior (EMAW), but I had doubts that I was ready for it.
