

Missions in Focus: Janet Spingath, Malawi

I will be going to Malawi July 2-16 as the LC3 representative to do sustainable gardening outreach for the orphans and villages served by the Passion Center for Children. I am going with two other people from a Christian school in Longview, Washington, who teach agriculture to K-12 students. We are going to teach how to use worm composting in a garden to fertilize plants and grow more food. The teachers from the Christian school will also be reporting back to their school about whether the Passion Center will be a good missionary support partner.

Prayer Points:

- Please pray we can make it to the villages and people who need to learn about growing more food in their gardens.
- Pray the in-country staff is able to make all the connections needed.
- Pray this little mission grows into something much larger and Malawi youth, served by the Passion Center, can participate in connecting with new (to them) methods of growing food that are based on biblical principles of stewardship of Creation.
- Pray that we return healthy and with a good report of what the Lord is doing from this practical service point of view.

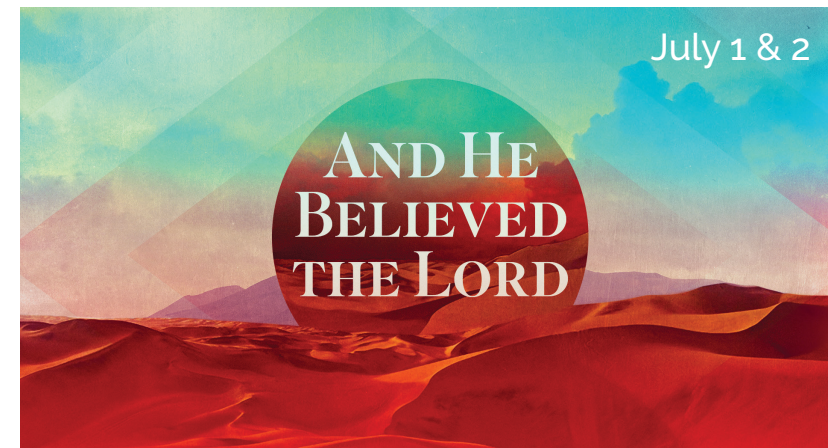

The Colson Fellows program is about equipping you to take your faith into every area of life.
