Collin & Elena Brown, Proclaim Aviation Ministries on loan to Moody Aviation

Collin and Elena have been serving with Proclaim Aviation Ministries on loan to Moody Aviation in Spokane since January 2024. Elena also serves part-time at Life Services Clinic, offering hope, truth, medical care, and support from a biblical perspective to women facing unplanned pregnancies.



Aviation plays a vital role in missions, helping transport missionaries, medical teams, supplies, Bibles, and humanitarian aid to remote regions that are otherwise difficult to reach. While this work carries inherent risks, it is a valuable tool for sharing Christ's love and the hope of the Gospel with those who may never otherwise hear.

As part of Moody Aviation's Production Team, Collin has helped maintain Moody's fleet of nearly 20 flight-training aircraft. Beginning July 8, he will transition into Moody's Certified Flight Instructor (CFI) course. This intensive training will prepare him to help train the next generation of missionary pilots and expand future opportunities for ministry through aviation. Collin is excited to return to flying and invest in the training of future missionary aviators who will serve around the world.
