Rosh Hashanah in Historical Context 1. The Biblical institution of Rosh Hashanah was in Lev. 23:23-25 & Num. 29:1-6	

- 2. The **themes** of Rosh Hashanah include:
 - A wake-up call (Isa. 58:1)
 - Covenant of remembrance (Exod. 19:18; Jer. 31:31-33)
 - Alarm of judgment (Amos 3:6; Joel 2:1)
 - Repentance and spiritual preparation (Isa. 58:1)
 - Return and restoration (Isa. 27:13)
 - Kingship of God (Ps. 47:5-8)

Rosh Hashanah and the Return of Jesus

- 1. The Feast of Trumpets is often linked exclusively to the Rapture of the Church, however:
 - Trumpets were used throughout the year in biblical times including the other Feasts.
 - All the Feasts have prophetic implications, not just the Fall Feasts.
 - The Feast of Trumpets will only be completely fulfilled in the Millennial Kingdom.

"To suggest that Yeshua fulfilled the Spring Feasts... with literal and exact precision, but will only fulfill the Fall Feasts spiritually or symbolically, would be inconsistent with the Scripture and the character of G-d." – Joshua Nunez

2. The Feast of Trumpets fundamentally foreshadows a Messianic ______ ceremony, where Messiah Jesus will be crowned as King in Jerusalem and reign from the throne of David in the Millennial Kingdom.

"Christians and Messianic Jews can celebrate the Feast of Trumpets today looking forward to the great coronation ceremony that will take place on God's holy mountain in the future... as a foretaste of the day when He will reign as King of the messianic age."  - Yom Kippur The Bride is received and beautified
 - **Sukkot** The Wedding Feast (Rev. 19:6-8)
