


What is the Rapture?

- 1. An important doctrine
- 2. A mystery or sacred secret (1 Cor. 15:51)
- 3. A distinct event from the Second Coming of Christ
- 4. A conclusion to the church age
- 5. A catching away (Rapturo, harpazo) of all living believers
- 6. A receiving of a glorified body (1 Thess. 4:16)
- 7. A promised return of Jesus for his bride (John 14:1-3) to escort her to heaven
- 8. A resurrection for those who are dead in Christ (1 Cor. 15:52; 1 Thess. 4:16)
- 9. An imminent event (1 Cor. 15:51; 1 Thess. 4:15)
- 10. An instantaneous event (1 Cor. 15:51-52a)
- 11. A traditional doctrine of the church that is now being recovered
- 12. A truth that brings comfort to believers (1 Thess. 4:18)

Reasons to trust in the Pre-Tribulation Rapture of the church

- 1. The tribulation's _____ concerns Israel (Jer. 30:7; Dan. 9:24)
- 2. It best explains the ______ between the Rapture and the Second Coming
- 3. There is no biblical reference to the church on earth during the Tribulation (Rev. 4-22)
- 4. The church is exempt from God's wrath (Rev. 3:10; 6:17; Rom. 5:9; 1 Thess. 1:10; 5:9)
- 5. The Rapture is imminent (1 Cor. 15:51; 1 Thess. 4:15)
- 6. The Rapture is a comfort (1 Thess. 4:18)
- 7. The Antichrist cannot come to power until the restrainer is removed (2 Thess. 2:6-7)
- 8. The symbolic parallels (2 Peter 2:5-9)
 - ◆ All of these taken _____ provide a very convincing case!

The Tribulation's purpose concerns Israel rather than the church

- 1. God has two distinct programs; one for Israel and another for the church (Dan. 12:7)
- 2. "The essence of Dispensationalism, then, is the distinction between Israel and the church." (Charles Ryrie, May/June 2007 article in Israel My Glory magazine)
- 3. Jeremiah 30:7
- 4. Daniel 9:24-27
- 5. Ephesians 3:9
- 6. Dispensation comes from the Greek word **oikonomia** and is translated "a plan," "a stewardship," or a "dispensation." The lexical meaning is "the process of managing or supervising the affairs of another or of a house." (Biblegateway article on dispensation)
