This year's Man Camp will be my third LC3 Man Camp experience, and I can heartily recommend it to the men of our church.



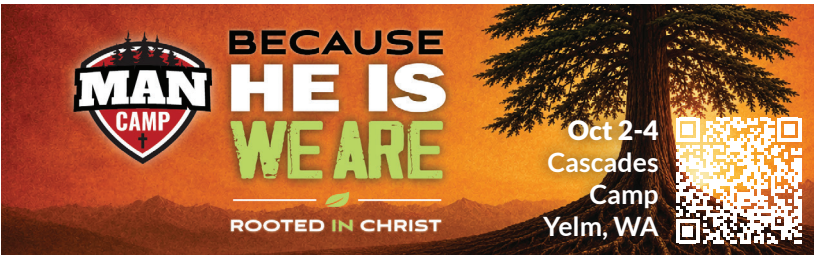
