MISSIONS IN FOCUS: Table of Nations (LC3)

Malawi is grappling with the devastation caused by Cyclone Freddy. We praise God our LC3 supported missionaries are safe: Ron Letendre, Kossi & Whitney Apki and the Passion Center. The death toll has now risen to over 500, with over 490,098 people displaced and almost 500 still missing. Many areas are too difficult to reach, making search and rescue assistance impossible. The cyclone has caused untold trauma, loss, and hopelessness.

The Passion Center staff continues to take food and other essential supplies to emergency camps and villages, helping those who've lost everything. They also pray with and share encouragement from the Bible at each visit, giving hope to the hopeless. Of the houses they've visited so far, all are either destroyed or unlivable. One example of the devastation is the home of four orphans that collapsed completely. The family was evacuated to a nearby school housing over 1100 people. Though now they have safe shelter, they went three days without food before relief came. This is the type of challenge many are facing. Our prayers and support are needed.
