Ice Breaker: Share a time when someone gave you a blessing.

1. When Jacob tells Rebekah he is afraid he will incur a curse instead of a blessing for deceiving his father, she replies: “Let your curse be on me, my son; only obey my voice, and go, bring them to me.” ([Gen. 27:13](#))
Discuss this verse as a group. Feel free to consult some commentaries to help your discussion.

2. After Esau is told that his blessing has been given to Jacob, here's what he says: "Have you but one blessing, my father? Bless me, even me also, O my father.' And Esau lifted up his voice and wept.'" ([Gen. 27:38](#))

Discuss this verse as a group. Why do you think Isaac could only give one blessing? Again, consult commentaries to help with your discussion.

3. Share a time in your life when you struggled with how God chose to answer your prayer. How did you resolve that struggle?

4. What are some examples of how parents can model godly behavior to their kids every day?
5. Who do you think is more to blame for this stolen blessing: Rebekah or Jacob? Why?
