

OFFERING A GIFT BACK TO GOD

Being part of the LC3 Photography Team has touched my life in ways I didn't expect. When I first joined, I thought I was simply offering a skill — taking photos. But God has used this ministry to soften my heart, deepen my faith, and open my eyes to the beauty of His people.



Behind the camera, I witness moments some people may never see - of quiet prayers, genuine smiles, tears during worship, families reconnecting, and people stepping into church carrying both hope and hurt. Capturing these moments has reminded me that God is moving constantly in big ways, in small ways, and in ways we only notice when we slow down and truly look.
