Yom Kippur in Historical Context

- 1. Yom Kippur established on the 10th day of Tishri
- 2. Leviticus is laser focused on the _____ of God and ____ in everyday life
- 3. Holiness matters to God. He dictates to Moses laws about fellowship, administering offerings, priestly consecration, purity, and disease (Lev 1-15)
- 4. Moses ordains Aaron and his sons (Lev 8:31-35)
- 5. God's holiness demonstrated: Lev 10:1-3, 1 Sam 6:19, Isaiah 6:1-7

Command

Timing: Lev 16:1-2, Lev 23:26-28

Scope: The original language is plural: Yom hakippurim means the day of Atonements

Audience: The priest, God's people

Definition: Satisfying a wrong or injury, or making restitution for a mistake; reuniting

At-ONE-ment: reconciling us to God by bridging the gap caused by our sin

Purpose: Introspection, repentance, purification, recommitment, restored fellowship

Priestly tasks: Personal cleansing and clothing, incense, sin offerings: 1 bull, 2 goats (one is the intended scapegoat), make atonement for holy place, tabernacle, altar

Blood matters: It is _____ that makes atonement for the soul (Lev 17:11), Heb 9:22

Specifics: **Do:** prepare, humble your soul, rest and reflect **Don't:** Do any work

Christ in the Day of Atonement

When? Sometime after Jesus returns.

Sin is still a problem, solved by Jesus: "God presented Him as a sacrifice of atonement" (Rom 3:25)

Jesus is the ultimate fulfillment of the LORD's promises, the ultimate High Priest!

Jesus is:

- The Guarantor of a better covenant (Heb 7:22)
- The perfect High Priest forever (Heb 7:28)
- Seated on the throne at God's right hand (Heb 8:1-2)
- The Way! (Heb 9:8, John 14:6)
- Our Mediator and a once-and-for-all sacrifice (Heb 9:15)
- Our Scapegoat (Heb 13:11)
