1. God's Message: Ezekiel is God's Watchman, called to proclaim both the imminent judgment and the eventual restoration of God's chosen people.
2. The Theme of Ezekiel: "You will know that I am the Lord."

1 Vision, 4 Sections, 70 Elders, 6 men, Zero Glory, 2 Prophecies

When: Sep 17, 592 B.C. (8:1)

Act 1: Willful Idolatry (The image of Jealousy) (1-6)

Act 2: Wicked Wall Art (7-13)

"Law of Solid Ground: Leaders Pay for Conduct No One Sees"
