

MISSION IN FOCUS: Russ & Lynda Hersman, Wycliffe, South Sudan

Lynda and I are in Juba, South Sudan, where this past Saturday we celebrated 50 years of the work of Bible translation in Sudan. We have been connected with you for 48 of those years, which means that LC3 has also been connected to this ministry work for 48 years!

So many lives and communities have changed through your global ministry with us in Wycliffe. Thank you for walking with us, praying with us, and seeing God's hand move through the power of His Word in the mother tongue of the Sudanese people.



Pray With Us

- There is still a horrendous war in Sudan. Many are suffering terribly, but in spite of that I hear reports regularly of how God is meeting Sudanese in their dreams and visions and they are turning to follow Jesus.
- The Avokaya Old Testament project is closing in on the completion of the entire Bible in Avokaya. Two weeks ago, two of the four translators tragically died in a plane crash as they were returning from taking new copies of the Avokaya Scriptures to one of their communities in the southern part of the country. Pray for their families and for the two remaining translators who are trying to continue.
- This is our 50th year of ministry in Wycliffe Bible Translators, which is an extension of the LC3 global ministry. We thank God for you!
