






Communion Weekend

MISSION IN FOCUS: David & Julie Ayer, Tanzania

Recent unrest in Tanzania following contested elections has created instability, travel concerns, and limited access to services. Yet God has shown kindness and protection as the Ayers minister to hundreds of sickle-cell affected families, bring feminine hygiene education and care to schools, and partner with local churches to share the Gospel.

Most urgently, their six-year-old son JJ is suffering from lung and breathing complications and is currently on oxygen and medication. The family traveled to Burundi for better medical care due to the situation in Tanzania and the need for reliable internet for their older children's school exams. The Ayers praise God for the warm welcome they received from friends and the mission hospital staff in Kibuye.

Prayer Requests

- Praise God for His guidance and provision these past days.
- For complete healing for JJ's lungs, and for strengthened faith and perseverance for the whole family.
- For Caleb and Maija as they finish exams at Liberty University and travel safely to Tanzania via Burundi (due to the current unrest) for a month.
- For peace and protection over Tanzania, and for their ministry in the southern regions—that through medical outreach, discipleship, pastoral training, children's ministry, and Gospel cinema, many would hear the Good News, respond in faith, and find true hope in Jesus.
