We are now back in Oregon, where I will continue working remotely with Frontiers until John and I discern what God has next for us. Bread of Life Food Bank is a ministry of LC3 to our local community. Our faithful volunteers meet every week to inventory new food, organize and stock the shelves, and (on Thursdays) transform the Gym Lobby into a food bank.

One client said that without the food bank, she'd have to decide whether to purchase her medication or get gas for her car.


Right now, the Food Bank needs school supplies to distribute to these families. You may drop them off in the Food Bank bin in the Lower Lobby.


