After much discussion and prayerful consideration, we have decided to conclude our annual Party at the Park event. We are incredibly grateful for the many memories, connections, and moments of community this event has created. As our church family has grown to more than 1,800 people, we have been encouraged to thoughtfully evaluate how we steward our time, finances, and resources to best support the ministries and opportunities God is placing before us. We remain deeply committed to continuing to Love God + Love People and are excited for the ways we can invest in the future ministry and growth of our church family.

MISSION IN FOCUS: Richard Mutura, CTC, Africa

My name is Richard Mutura, PhD, President of Community Transformation Centre. God has opened incredible doors for ministry in Kakuma Refugee Camp, home to more than 310,000 refugees representing 22 countries and over 60 people groups.

We are celebrating a significant milestone: in recognition of the ministry's impact, the United Nations allocated two acres of land for a new training center. Through the faithful support of LC3, we have completed the perimeter fence and built two structures with combined seating for 300 people.

Today, this has become a Centre for All Nations—a place where communities are being discipled, empowered, and transformed through the gospel. More than 600 children are currently being impacted, and nearly 800 people have graduated from our programs. We are also grateful to partner with Moody Bible Institute for the certification of our pastors' training program.

LETTING GO TO RELY ON GOD

I grew up in the church, and about two years ago I started attending LC3 with my daughter Sarah and her family.

Last year was my first women's conference at LC3, and I was hooked. I couldn't wait to get my ticket for this year—but I had no idea just how much I would need it.

For the past 16 years, my mom has been battling Alzheimer's, and she is now in the late stages. My dad has faced health struggles over the last couple of years, and my brother has been fighting colon cancer for the past five years. I've been the main support person through so many of these difficult moments.

This weekend, my brother went back into the hospital, and since the conference, we've been told there's nothing more that can be done.

While I was at the conference, singing the beautiful hymns that spoke so deeply to my heart, I finally let go and cried.

And then there was Mariah, the conferenced speaker. I truly believe she was there to speak directly to me—about letting go, reaching out, and allowing Jesus to take control. She reminded me that everything is in God's hands, that Jesus can heal even from far away, that He sees our pain and wants us to rely on Him.

Every message she shared spoke straight to my soul. I needed to hear the way she broke down Scripture and made it so clear and personal.

I also met incredible women in my small group who stayed late, listened to me, talked with me, and prayed with me.

I will forever be touched by the Refresh Women's Conference in more ways than I can fully express. It has deepened my faith in a way I didn't even realize I needed.

I already can't wait for next year.
