Our church planting team recently had the joy of launching "Followers International Church" in a heavily atheistic pocket of eastern Berlin (only a few miles from the former GDR/Stasi headquarters). Church growth and conversions are uncommon here, but we trust that God will accomplish His purposes for this little church. It was fun to have a couple of new visitors who are now coming regularly! Every third Friday, the gentle hum of our sewing machines fills the room, mingled with laughter, prayer, and the steady rhythm of scissors cutting fabric. Around the tables sit women of all ages, joined together by a simple desire: to use the skills God has given us to bless others.

We are Stitching Sisters—a ministry where fellowship and purpose are stitched into every seam. Some of us sew blankets for local organizations, others piece together items for international mission projects. Each finished piece becomes more than fabric—it becomes a gift of love. We pray over every item, asking God to use it so the receiver might experience His care and compassion.

As 1 Peter 4:10 reminds us: "As each has received a gift, use it to serve one another, as good stewards of God's varied grace." That's exactly what happens here.
