When God Destroyed

Genesis 19:15-38

Pastor Tung shared about the yellow comb his dad would use daily. Share an object you remember from your childhood that brings good memories (a piece of furniture, a toy, a favorite location, etc.)

- Pastor Tung quoted Trip Lee: "If you're not fighting sin, you're befriending your sin." Do you agree with this statement? Why or why not?
- 2. One of the consequences of our sin is that it separates us; it can break fellowship with other believers, and it can bring a separation in our relationship with God. Since we can't lose our salvation, what does this separation look like and how can one

- be restored? (<u>Psalm 103:12</u>; <u>Hebrews</u> 8:12; <u>1 John 1:9</u>; <u>Psalm 51</u>)
- 3. Have you elevated certain sins above others? What does God's Word say?
- 4. Pastor Tung challenged us to surround ourselves with believers and be in regular community or fellowship with other believers. How has this group encouraged you in your faith walk? Can you share a recent example?
- 5. Genesis 19 was a difficult passage to read, but God displayed His grace and mercy. That is who He is. Discuss God's grace and mercy in this passage. How have you seen God's grace and mercy this week, in your own life or in our community?

End your time praying for any specific needs of forgiveness or healing, asking for God's grace and mercy in those places.
