- Disputes & wars among nations (Matt. 24:6-7a)
- The increase of disease and natural disasters (Luke 21:11; Matt. 24:7b-8)
- Persecution of Christians will increase (Matt. 24:9)
- The rebirth of the nation of Israel (Ezek. 36-37; 38:8)
- Technology to communicate to the entire world (Rev. 11:9)
- Technology for the mark of the Beast (Rev. 13:16-18)
- Groundwork for a one world government, economy, & religion (Rev. 13:7-8, 16-18; 17:9-18)
