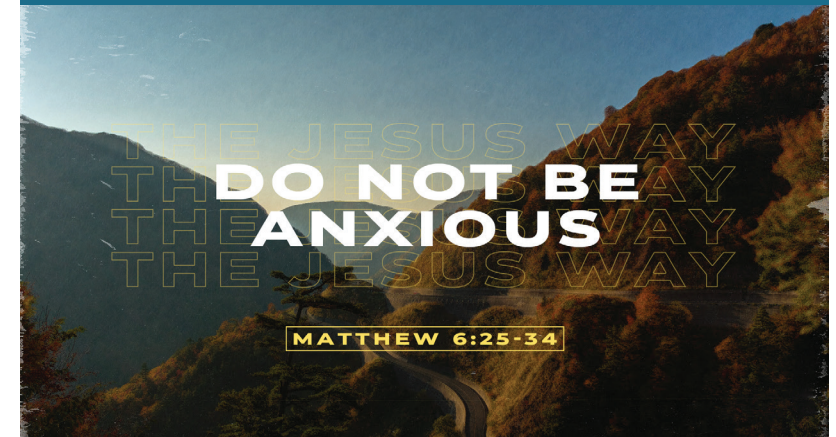

LC3 Global Missions Team Shifting strategies in Ukraine

During the invasion of Ukraine by Russia, Westerners (including missionaries supported by LC3) were expelled from Dagestan. As a result, the K-umyk, @kkin, and Nog@i (KAN) Team shifted its focus to the Turco-Russian region and increased support towards missionaries who are natives of the area both culturally and linguistically.

By partnering with Global Teams, we have donated funds to train church planters, equipping them to develop and multiply young leaders. Another successful initiative has been supporting the training of women Muslim Background Believers (MBB) who are enthusiastic about spreading the Gospel. Building on this achievement, advanced training (including a companion mentorship program) has been scheduled for early next year.


