
There were so many highlights and praises; here are a few:

THE CHURCH THAT CARES LC3 COMMUNITY GARDEN

Many people coming to LC3 are not aware of the small community garden behind the church gym. There are twenty boxes of raised beds that belong primarily to people who live close enough to the church to walk to the garden. Some attend LC3 and some don't. Some don't believe in Jesus, and some do but don't follow Him closely. All of them must water their gardens by hand or make friends with fellow gardeners who will do it for them.



The purpose of this garden at LC3 is to facilitate relationships in the neighborhood. Several times a season, gardeners have a potluck to share food and laughter. Gardening is a quiet activity and lends itself to personal conversations. Along with discussions about pruning tomatoes and harvesting broccoli, there have been conversations about life after death and Jesus' value of women. Support for one another has been astonishing. Recently a member was hospitalized for two months due to a motorcycle accident. Everyone offered emotional support, and one person donated funds to cover a substantial amount of the medical costs.

At the center of the garden is a little red house painted with giant sunflowers. The Little Library, with a similar motif, was built by an Eagle Scout; it sits on the garden fence and sees frequent use. By creating places for relationships and caring for our community through opportunities such as the community garden, LC3 is becoming known by employees at Lakewood City Hall as, "That church that cares about the community." And isn't that what a community church should be known for?
