This will be a special "mini missions" trip, where our boys will get to experience the culture and ministry firsthand before we launch into full-time ministry in August. We are also looking forward to practicing our Chichewa language, which we have been learning over the past few months.



We recently hosted a luncheon for over 145 people and are praising God that we are currently at 81% of our monthly support-raising goal. We have seen great momentum over the last two months. Our Military Community Group has had a meaningful impact on my life. One of the things I love most is the smaller setting. I'm not very outgoing when I arrive somewhere new—I tend to observe quietly and take things in.
