SIMAIR has become a vital travel link with the deteriorating security situation in Niger. Although we are limited to flying only to our two hospitals, we are busy flying the many people who generously give of their time and resources to come and volunteer at our hospitals.

Prayer Requests:

- Muslims would see an attractive beauty in the freedom and love that a relationship with Jesus brings compared to the legalism of Islam.
- Limitations on SIMAIR lifted so we can fly to all locations in Niger and not only to our two hospitals.
- Our family relationships, both nuclear and within the mission community. Getting along with people is hard sometimes and it's made even harder when living in difficult circumstances. Pray that we would conduct ourselves with grace and love and that each of us would live up to our God given roles.
- For wisdom as we plan our furlough for some time in 2024-2025.
