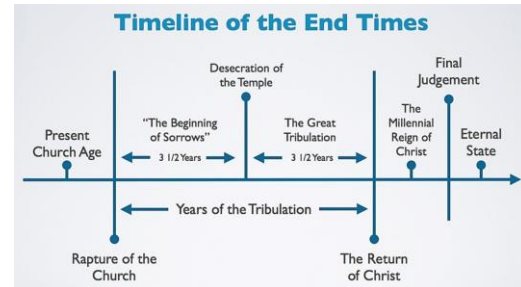


Revelation: Hope for the Last Days

- Rev. 14 includes **seven proclamations** given from the divine side, aimed at doing 3 things:

 - Announcing the _____ of the approaching last seven judgments (the bowl judgments)
 - Giving words of assurance, encouragement, and _____ to the saints living in the second half of the Tribulation
