## MISSION IN FOCUS: Wayne & Jaymi Craig, Every Man A Warrior (EMAW)

One of the greatest needs in Christ's Church today is spiritually mature men — men who are disciplined and taught how to walk with God for a lifetime, and who understand their calling as godly husbands and fathers.

Spiritual multiplication is God's plan to reach men on a global scale, and I'm overjoyed to report that we are now in our 3rd generation of leaders in the collegiate ministry in Uganda. We are seeing this same growth in the prisons of Kenya. Across Africa, God has raised up collegiate leaders in eight countries, prison ministry leaders in nine countries, and country leaders in 26 countries.

Almost daily, I receive messages of men being set free from the slavery of pornography, husbands pursuing the hearts of their wives, and fathers pursuing the hearts of their children. God has done this. Thank you, LC3, for allowing the Lord to work through you as we labor together to equip men — locally and globally. God is at work to reach men and raise up an Army of workers for the harvest fields of the world. Thank you for covering us with your prayers.

### Pray with Us:

- Pray for the Continental Leadership meetings being planned in Africa.
- Pray for the new countries of Pakistan, India, Mongolia, Thailand, Egypt, Gabon, Cameroon where EMAW is being established and the restart of the ministry in the Philippines.
- Pray for the new prison ministry in Idaho. I am starting an EMAW in a prison where active occultic gangs are at work. The first four weeks were personally difficult but fruitful.
