# Sukkot: The Feast of Tabernacles

## Introduction

1. The Festivals (Mo'edim) = The \_\_\_\_\_ times (Lev. 23:1-4)
  - God wants a relationship with \_\_\_\_\_
2. These feasts are also called holy convocations = Miqra = assembly = \_\_\_\_\_
3. The Apostle Paul says that the festivals are a "shadow of what is \_\_\_\_\_" (Col. 2:17)
4. The Feasts are a Divine \_\_\_\_\_ for how God wants to connect with His children and for what He has planned for our future.

"The Mo'edim are eternal rhythms that anchor heaven's plan to earth's timeline... Just as Yeshua literally became the Passover Lamb, so too He will literally return at the Fall Festivals, bring final atonement (Zech. 12:10), and dwell among His people during Sukkot (Zech. 14; Rev. 21)." – Joshua Nunez

5. The Fall Feasts portray the **return of the King**:
  - Rosh Hashanah** – The return & coronation of the King (the Rapture or Second Coming)
  - Yom Kippur** – The King's Temple is purified (or the people are redeemed)
  - Sukkot** – The King's dwelling with His people in the Kingdom

## Sukkot in Historical Context

1. The Biblical **institution of Sukkot** was in Lev. 23:33-43 & Deut. 16:13-17
2. The **8<sup>th</sup> day** (Shimini Atzeret) of the 7 day feast pictures \_\_\_\_\_! (Lev. 23:36, 39)
3. The **themes of Sukkot** include:
  - A harvest festival to celebrate God's provision (Exod. 23:16)
  - Living \_\_\_\_\_ to commemorate the Exodus (Lev. 23:42-43; Mt. 17:1-4)
  - The \_\_\_\_\_ of God's creation (Lev. 23:40)
  - Rejoicing over God's faithfulness (Lev. 23:40; Deut. 16:13-14)
  - The celebration of \_\_\_\_\_ (Isa. 58:11; Joel 2:28; John 7:1-10; 37-39)
  - The \_\_\_\_\_ of the Temple ceremony (Isa. 9:2; 60:19-20; John 8:12)

## Sukkot and the Return of Jesus

1. Sukkot is \_\_\_\_\_ of the biblical calendar because it signifies the end goal of God's entire redemptive plan (Isaiah 25:6-9).
2. Sukkot is a picture of the coming \_\_\_\_\_ when Jesus will tabernacle among His people, ruling and reigning from David's throne in Jerusalem (Micah 4:7).
3. Sukkot will be celebrated in Jerusalem annually during \_\_\_\_\_ (Ezekiel 45:21-25; Zech. 14:16-19).
4. The Fall Feasts tell a **divine love story**:  
**Rosh Hashanah** – The awakening and preparation of the Bride  
**Yom Kippur** – The Bride is received and beautified  
**Sukkot** – The Wedding Feast (Rev. 19:6-8)
