Bread of Life Food Bank is gearing up for our Thanksgiving and Christmas events for our clients. For Thanksgiving our goal is to provide enough food to prepare a complete holiday dinner for each family.

Christmas is a big event! The LC3 community provides gifts for Food Bank children through the Giving Tree. We also collect gifts during the year and open the Gym to let clients shop for anyone in their family that wasn't on the Giving Tree. We try to have ham and other items to make



their celebration special. It is great to see the smiles on their faces, and it gives our volunteers the opportunity to visit and invite them to the many events we have at the church during the season.

Prayer Requests

- Pray for 1 or 2 able-bodied men to help unload trucks Thursday mornings from 8-10 am. Also, pray for 1 or 2 people that can push out carts and help load the groceries in clients' cars on Thursday afternoons from 1-5 pm. This is a great opportunity to connect with the clients, get to know them, and pray with them.
- Our numbers are increasing so pray we will be able to continue to have enough food. We currently serve 150 families a week, which is a 30% increase over this time last year.
- Pray also as we get closer to Christmas that we have a good number of people to sign up and help with the Client Christmas Party on December 14.




