
Praver Requests

A STORY OF ANSWERED PRAYER HALLE WILKENING

In the fall, I will be a junior at Steilacoom High School, and I have been attending Lake City Community Church my whole life. Here is my story from the youth mission trip to Dream Center in Los Angeles.

The week leading up to the Dream Center trip, I was praying God would use my past trials and experiences to help someone else in theirs. After I prayed for her, I looked up, and she was in tears. She hugged me, and said "Thank you baby, I needed this."

Looking back, I am beyond thankful that God answered my prayer and used my past experiences to give hope to someone else.


