MISSION IN FOCUS

ANDY & NIKKI GRAY, SIM, WEST AFRICA

This past year, we continued to base out of the US to support family needs. We spent March, April, and part of May in Benin, West Africa, teaching several weeks of marriage and family courses at the French-speaking Bible institute.



We will return to Benin this October and November for consultation with a local pastor on our new sexuality curriculum (parent to child family-based curriculum). We hope to complete this and then teach it twice before we leave in December. If possible, we will team-teach this class with the Benin pastor!

Andy received a visa to return to Niger at the beginning of 2026, but Nikki's application was unexpectedly rejected. We are praying about Andy going there for a short stay without Nikki in January or February.

Prayer Requests:

- Pray for safe travel and God's favor as we go back to Benin September 30 – December 2.
- Pray for meaningful connections with pastors in training who have a heart for family ministry.
- Pray for our new material about sexuality to be practical and engaging.
- Pray for us to have God's eyes to see how we can be a blessing to the Christian community in Benin.

BRINGING HOPE TO ISRAEL AN LC3 STUDENT

Almost a year ago, we had the opportunity to send one of our high school students to bring the Gospel of Jesus to the unreached. (For privacy, we will call this student "Lani.") Lani traveled to the land where redemption began—and where restoration will have its grand finale: the Promised Land of Israel.

Lani attended a youth camp with participants from around the world, aimed at equipping the next generation through the creative arts—music, video, dance, photography, and more. Each day, the youth would take what they had learned and created and go into public spaces to share, in both Hebrew and Arabic, the love and hope we have in Messiah. As they sang worship songs in the public square, those listening—often in awe—would come up to ask, "How is it that in such a time as this, you are singing such beautiful songs in Hebrew and Arabic?"

These moments became Spirit-led opportunities for the youth to share the only hope for Israel and all nations—Yeshua the Messiah, born in Bethlehem (Micah 5:2), who will one day (soon, we pray) return to rule in Jerusalem (Zech. 14; Rev. 21).

Because of this hope, Lani and the youth felt safer than ever in the Land He chose: "For the LORD has chosen Zion... 'This is My resting place forever...'" (Psalm 132:13-14 ESV).

Pray that, like Lani, LC3 would continue to have a Kingdom impact both locally and globally. As we enter the Biblical Fall Festivals and approach the second anniversary of October 7, please pray for the peace and salvation of Jerusalem (Ps. 122; Zech. 12:10; Rom. 11).
