#### What does it mean to be a saint?

#### **Read Revelation 7:9-17:**

- 1. Who is speaking in verse 9?
- 2. Who is the Lamb and what does this image remind you of in the Bible?
- 3. Do verses 9-12 remind you of any specific events in Jesus' life?
- 4. Do you recognize how we use the words from verse 12 in our Divine Service?
- 5. How do verses 15-17 help us understand what heaven will be like?

#### **Read 1 John 3:1-3:**

- 1. What kind of love has the Father given to us?
- 2. What is the result of this love?
- 3. What is our present state and what is our future?
- 4. How is one purified?

#### Read Matthew 5:1-12:

- 1. From where does the blessing come in the beatitudes; from God or from the deeds of people?
- 2. What change do you notice in the language of verse 11?
- 3. Verse 11 speaks of what will happen to Jesus' disciples, yet verse 12 speaks of what already is true, why is this so important?
