(As the bells ring, please stand and turn to face the processional cross.)

Leader: In Him was life, and the life was the light of men. The light shines in the darkness, and the darkness has not overcome it.

Leader: The true light, which enlightens everyone, was coming into the world. He was in the world, and the world was made through Him, yet the world did not know Him.

People: Glory to God in the highest!


Leader: Who were born, not of blood nor of the will of the flesh

1 O come, all ye faithful, Joyful and triumphant! O come ye, O come ye to Bethlehem; Come and behold Him Born the king of angels:










Leader: Lord God, heavenly Father,
