# ROM 209 - Rejoice Through & Beyond Suffering- Rom 5:1-11

Into every Christian Life - Comes Trials & Suffering

<u>last week</u> - from <u>Pastor Jeff</u> - we learned about the "<u>Benefits of Suffering</u>" (very good msg - get it)

Well, these **2 msg's** - are going to **Go Together** 

#### This week - We're going to look at

Rejoicing THRU our Suffering Rejoicing BEYOND our Suffering

Many of us - right now - are going thru trials in our lives some of us w/ trials pressing in from every direction

& <u>it's **pretty easy**</u> for those <u>trials</u> to get us <u>discouraged</u>, even to - <u>Take Us Out</u>

If that's you today - if you're "Holding On" in a Storm

then **God** wants to *give you* - some *Serious Hope* from His Word

Your God - who Loves you so much - Wants you to be able to Rejoice THRU & BEYOND the suffering you face today

He wants to **Give you Joy** *THRU & BEYOND* your Trials

# **Let's Pray**

The <u>Apostle Paul's</u> middle name may has well been "<u>suffering</u>" because <u>that's what he found</u> wherever he went

### From the time he made Jesus Christ his Lord -Paul was:

- Put to hard labor
- Beaten
- Imprisoned
- Given 39 lashes 5 times
- Shipwrecked 3 times
- & Stoned & Left for dead

Yet his rejoicing seemed to <u>constantly increase</u> In <u>every trial</u> – In <u>every tribulation</u>

And <u>we can have</u> that same supernatural <u>Rejoicing</u>
<u>THRU</u> & even <u>BEYOND</u> our <u>trials</u> & <u>tribulations</u>

**That** is what **God** wants *you to know* today

**God wants** to give you a *confident expectation*, a *guarantee* 

<u>a confidence</u> that <u>doesn't</u> come from within <u>you</u> but a <u>confidence</u> that comes <u>from</u> <u>God</u> <u>to</u> you

In our passage today - Paul begins to "turn a corner" in Romans

He's **not** so much **Proving his Point** (like the previous 4 Ch's)

but <u>instead</u> - today he <u>begins to address</u> <u>Living The Christian LIFE</u>

#### In general - there are THREE Phases of the Christian Life;

1) <u>Justification</u> - <u>being declared righteous</u>

(by faith - at salvation)

2) <u>Sanctification</u> - the transformation of your earthly life (living the Christian Life)

3) Glorification - the final eternal transformation (heaven)

In <u>Rom Ch 5</u> - Paul transitions from <u>Justification</u> (where we've been) to <u>Sanctification</u> (where we're going)

AND - One Clear Sign of that is;

Here in Ch 5 - Paul <u>switches</u> his vocabulary to using the "First Person Plural" - WE

# For the 1<sup>st</sup> time in Romans - Paul is now saying WE;

since **WE** have been *justified* 

**WE** have *peace* with God

WE have access into God's Grace

**WE** rejoice in *hope* 

WE rejoice in suffering

God's Love has been poured into OUR hearts

His Holy Spirit has been given to US

While **WE** were still sinners

Christ died for US

WE were reconciled

**WE** are saved

WE shall REJOICE

**22 TIMES** - Paul says **WE** - **OUR** - **US** . . . 22 times in 11 Vs's

Paul's <u>no longer</u> <u>Proving his Point</u> of the <u>great truth</u> of <u>Justification by Faith Alone</u>

He's now drawing us INTO the Great Rejoicing we have IN Jesus Christ & BY the Holy Spirit

Rejoicing designed to <u>be experienced</u> THRU - & BEYOND our Trials & Suffering

### Rom 5:1 - ESV

1 <u>Therefore</u>, <u>since</u> we have been justified by faith, we have peace <u>with</u> God through our Lord Jesus Christ.

The <u>THEREFORE</u> ties these truths of <u>Sanctification</u> to the <u>Foundation Truths</u> of <u>Justification</u> we've just gone thru

THEREFORE - because of the Previous Truths of <u>Justification</u>
SINCE we have been justified by faith

We <u>HAVE</u> - <u>WE OWN</u>, <u>POSSESS</u> - **Peace** <u>WITH</u> God through our Lord Jesus Christ

The word WITH (in 'peace with God') - means LIT - FACING

Being Justified by Faith - We have Peace - when we are "Facing God"

**Because of** the *Righteousness* of Jesus Christ we stand **Guiltless** - & **Un-condemned** before God

<u>That</u> is the beginning - of our <u>being able to Rejoice</u> <u>NO MATTER</u> what goes on in this life

& so we've got to get a hold of this

# **Col 1:22 - NLT**

22 Yet now he (God) has reconciled you to himself through the death of Christ in his physical body. As a result, he (God) has brought you into his own presence, and you are holy and blameless as you stand before him without a single fault.

\*THAT - is Justification - & it's the beginning of \*True Rejoicing\* & we've got to \*Cling\* to \*this knowledge\* - & \*Stand Firm\* in it

Just look at the next Vs. in Col Ch 1

# **Col 1:23 - NLT [show with v.22]**

23 But you must continue to believe this truth and stand firmly in it. Don't drift away from the assurance you received when you heard the Good News. . .

The <u>beginning</u> of <u>ALL</u> <u>Rejoicing</u> is the fact that - <u>God</u> has <u>Reconciled us</u> to <u>Himself</u>

& THAT is how Paul's going to END out text today too

But Not only is Jesus Christ our <u>Peace WITH God</u>
He is also our <u>Guaranteed ACCESS</u> - into God's Grace

#### **Rom 5:2 - ESV**

2 <u>Through him</u> [Jesus Christ] we have also obtained access by faith into this grace in which we stand, and we rejoice in hope of the glory of God.

Thru Him (Jesus) we have <u>Access</u> into the <u>Incredible</u> Grace of God

- <u>"ACCESS"</u> comes from two words meaning *"To Bring Facing"* the picture is of a <u>formal escort</u> into <u>the presence of royalty</u>
- Like <u>that young boy</u> who was <u>crying</u> outside <u>Buckingham Palace</u> <u>because</u> the guards had <u>refused</u> to let him see <u>the Queen</u>
- But then, Prince Charles heard the boy crying & he took him by the hand & said "come with me, I will give you full access to the Queen"
- & <u>at that point</u> there was <u>nothing</u> that would <u>stop that boy</u> from <u>getting an audience</u> w/ <u>the Queen</u>
- with <u>Prince Charles</u> going before him, there was an <u>Abundance of Grace</u> <u>just waiting</u> for him in the <u>Throne Room</u>

**GRACE** - is God's <u>unlimited</u>, <u>unmerited</u>, <u>underserved</u> **favor** that He **pours out** - <u>onto us</u>

#### **WHY ??**

Because <u>Jesus Christ</u> has walked us into the <u>Throne Room of Grace</u>

& we <u>STAND</u> before God - "<u>In Christ</u>" worthy to receive all of God's Grace to be poured out on us

### Heb 4:16 - ESV

16 Let us then with confidence draw near to the throne of grace, that we may receive mercy and find grace to help in time of need.

**THAT** - is the **Grace** in which we **STAND** 

#### So now

- #1) We can Rejoice because we have Peace with God thru Jesus Christ
- #2) We can Rejoice because we have full Escorted Access into the *Throne Room* of God's Grace thru Jesus Christ

# & then - at the END of V.2 we read;

and we rejoice in hope of the glory of God.

# But look at it in the NLT (end of V.2)

2... and we <u>confidently</u> and <u>joyfully</u> <u>look forward</u> to sharing God's glory.

We're talking about **REJOICING THRU & BEYOND** our *Trials* & *Suffering* 

So <u>let me give you</u> - - the #3 Reason for some <u>Serious Rejoicing</u>;

we confidently and joyfully look forward to sharing God's glory

<u>I know</u> what you may be <u>experiencing</u> <u>right now</u> may be <u>Excruciatingly Difficult</u> - maybe <u>Crushing</u> beyond belief

#### But I need you to KNOW;

- #1) You have **Peace** With God, *thru Jesus Christ*
- #2) You receive God's Unlimited Grace, thru Jesus Christ
- #3) You can <u>confidently & joyfully</u> look forward to sharing <u>God's Glory</u>, <u>thru Jesus Christ</u>

Now <u>THAT</u> is <u>THREE</u> very good reasons to start <u>Rejoicing</u> <u>THRU & BEYOND</u> your <u>Suffering</u>

#### But maybe you'd say;

"OK, I can see - Rejoicing **BEYOND** by Trials . . .

(MEANING - SEEING BEYOND THEM TO A TIME OF REJOICING)

But what do you mean by - Rejoicing THRU my Trials?"

Well - what I actually mean is - Rejoicing IN THE MIDST of your Trials - WHILE you're actually going THRU them!

# Rom 5:3(A) - ESV

3 More than that, we rejoice in our sufferings, . . .

Oh come on now! - <u>Surely</u> you can't be serious ?? (<u>I am serious</u>, and please don't call me <u>Shirley</u>)

We have been <u>Promised By God</u> that <u>suffering</u> is a <u>natural occurrence</u> in this Life

But <u>Please Listen</u> - what Paul is about to say is what <u>every Christian</u> MUST <u>Learn</u>

Paul is <u>about to say</u> - we, <u>as Christians</u> <u>Rejoice IN</u> our sufferings,

BECAUSE of the beneficial effect - they have on our Life w/ Christ

<u>Paul's</u> about to say - that <u>our Sufferings</u> are <u>TOOLS</u> that are <u>used</u> to <u>develop our Confidence</u> in God

& because of that **Beneficial Effect** of our Suffering,

We can <u>Rejoice THRU</u> our sufferings (While in them)
<u>Looking forward</u> to Life <u>BEYOND</u> our sufferings (Thru & Beyond)

### OK - so How Does it Work?

### Rom 5:3-4 - ESV

3 More than that, we rejoice in our sufferings, knowing that suffering <u>produces</u> endurance,

4 and endurance <u>produces</u> character, and character <u>produces</u> hope,

Let's <u>first look</u> at the word "<u>PRODUCES</u>" it means to <u>achieve</u> or to <u>accomplish</u> something

& then - see that last word that our Suffering produces - - HOPE

Greek word for 'hope' is "el-pece"

But <u>Biblical hope</u> is **NOT** - "optimistic outlook" or "wishful thinking"

#### This word means;

a 'confident expectation' based on 'solid certainty'

#### Biblical HOPE is:

a 'confident expectation' based on 'solid certainty'

& guys - what you & I need when we're going thru a time of Suffering

is - a 'confident expectation' based on 'solid certainty'

#### So - How do we get it ?

well that's the part that's kinda hard for us to accept

Because <u>the Bible says</u> (right here) that **this hope** comes - **THRU** Suffering

#### Here are the steps;

suffering produces endurance (perseverance),
endurance produces character (a refining of who we are),
character produces hope (confident expectation)

#### Paraphrase using definitions:

"We rejoice that God <u>puts us under pressure</u>, to build up our <u>endurance</u>, in order to <u>refine us</u>, removing the dross & impurities, so that we might have a <u>confident expectation based on solid certainty</u>"

#### My second favorite saying;

"God is not as interested in making our circumstances right, as He is in <u>using</u> our circumstances to make <u>us</u> right!"

**Very Often** - God uses **Suffering** (LIT - *Pressure*)

As **the TOOL** to *create* true *spiritual maturity* & true *intimate relationship* with Him

#### Ask the great heroes of the Bible;

- Abraham will tell you about Mt Moriah & a glistening knife
- Jacob will tell you about a wrestling match & a permanent limp
- Joseph will tell you about a dungeon & false accusations
- David will sing you the Psalms written in the blackest nights of life
- Peter will speak of the pain of his own denial,
- John of the loneliness of the isle of Patmos
- & if you dare, Jesus will tell you of the Path to the cross

#### The path to God's deepest blessings

is often **Directly thru** the almost **unbearable pressure** of suffering

# & when we are under that **Divine Refining** of **Suffering**;

- If we will turn our hearts TOWARD God
  Rejoicing THRU & BEYOND our suffering
- & I Promise you His Grace WILL BE Sufficient for your Need
- & <u>only then</u> will we <u>begin to comprehend</u> the <u>exceeding greatness</u> of His <u>Power</u> & the <u>unlimited flow</u> of His <u>Grace</u>

& then we will be able to say with Paul in Rom 8:18

# Rom 8:18 - ESV

18 For I consider that the sufferings of this present time are not worth comparing with the glory that is to be revealed to us.

But 1<sup>st</sup> - We must <u>allow</u> the Master's <u>perfect work</u> to <u>bring</u> the <u>hope</u> He desires to <u>form in our lives</u>

Panic, anxiety, & negativity overcome me when I lose that confident expectation that God is with me,

when <u>I lose</u> that <u>confidence</u> - That my <u>Trials</u> are working in me a <u>far more exceeding weight</u> of <u>Glory</u>

# 2Cor 4:17-18 - NLT

17 For our present troubles are small and won't last very long. Yet they produce for us a glory that vastly outweighs them and will last forever!

18 So we don't look at the troubles we can see now; rather, we fix our gaze on things that cannot be seen. For the things we see now will soon be gone, but the things we cannot see will last forever.

So what's our job ??

to FIX OUR GAZE - on the things that cannot be seen

Which are the <u>Eternal Benefits</u> that our <u>Suffering</u> is <u>PRODUCING</u> In Us

For the things we see now will soon be gone, but the things we cannot see will last forever.

Why do we lose hope?

<u>Most often</u> - because we are <u>Fixing our Gaze</u> <u>ONLY</u> on the things that **CAN** be seen - Our Trials, Difficulties, Suffering

But **God says** those things will **soon be gone** 

But **the Benefits** of what He is producing **THRU** our **suffering THOSE** things will **last forever**!!

# We must allow God to use the TOOLS of this life

to <u>Produce</u> in us - <u>ENDURANCE</u> (perseverance) - So that <u>Endurance</u> can produce in us <u>CHARACTER</u> - so that <u>Character</u> can produce in us <u>HOPE</u>

which is a 'confident expectation' based on 'solid certainty'

<u>James</u> says the same thing in <u>Jas 1:2-4</u> (Jeff used this Last Wk)

Jas 1:2-4 - NLT  $\rightarrow$   $\rightarrow$ 

# Jas 1:2-4 - NLT

- 2 Dear brothers and sisters, when troubles come your way, consider it an opportunity for great joy.
- 3 For you know that when your faith is tested, your <u>endurance</u> has a chance to grow.
- 4 <u>So let it grow</u>, for when your endurance is fully developed, you will be <u>perfect</u> and <u>complete</u>, needing nothing.

#### If we will CONSIDER your Trials as

an Opportunity to KNOW GOD - & an Opportunity to GROW in CHRIST

Then the "*TOOLS*" of this life will have their perfecting work in us;

**producing** in us - that <u>confident expectation</u> that God is <u>AT WORK</u> **For our good** - **In the Midst of your Suffering** 

#### & **IN THAT** - YOU CAN **REJOICE**

#### SO-

- #1) You have Peace With God, thru Jesus Christ
- #2) You receive God's Unlimited Grace, thru Jesus Christ
- #3) You are going to share God's Glory, thru Jesus Christ
- #4) You can <u>rejoice</u> in the <u>Eternal Good</u> that God wants to bring <u>THRU</u> your suffering

#### & Now - in ROM 5:5

we have the **End Result** of this entire process

# Rom 5:5 - From The NLT

5 And this hope (confidence) will not lead to disappointment. For we know how dearly God loves us, because he has given us the Holy Spirit to fill our hearts with his love.

This <u>Hope</u> - This <u>Confidence</u> - will <u>NEVER</u> disappoint us because <u>we know</u> how dearly <u>God loves us</u> - - (do you see it?)

**THIS Hope** - That comes <u>THRU</u> our <u>suffering</u> <u>WILL NOT</u> lead to disappointment,

For we know how dearly God loves us, because he has given us the Holy Spirit to fill our hearts with his love

This is the First real Mention of the Holy Spirit in Romans

<u>& He</u> is mentioned <u>As a Guarantee</u> - of <u>the Hope</u> (that comes thru suffering) <u>never disappointing</u> us

WHY? - Because we know how dearly God loves us! WHY? - Because He has given us the Holy Spirit to fill our hearts with His love

# God's Agape Love - poured into our hearts by the Holy Spirit,

Is our <u>Guarantee</u> that the <u>HOPE</u> that comes <u>thru our Suffering</u> will <u>never</u> disappoint us

Now - since <u>God knew</u> that His <u>Agape Love</u> would be <u>more</u> than we <u>could grasp</u>

He has **Paul explain it** for us in the *following verses* 

### Vs. 6-8 is actually a **Demonstration** of *God's Agape Love*

to give us the **confidence** that *God is working* **THRU** our Suffering - *FOR* our *GOOD* 

### Rom 5:6-8 - ESV

6 For while we were still weak (NLT = utterly helpless), at the right time Christ died for the ungodly.

7 For one will scarcely die for a righteous person—though perhaps for a good person one would dare even to die—8 but God shows his love for us in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us.

Paul has well <u>convinced us</u> - that we have <u>nothing</u> to <u>offer God</u> no <u>redeeming qualities</u> at all

Yet Christ still <u>died</u> for us - <u>in our place</u> so that we could be <u>Declared Righteous</u> before God

**The REASON** Christ died for us while we were still sinners is *God's Agape Love* 

& **Because** God's Agape Love is *totally unmerited* & *not dependent* on us in any way,

Since it is wholly based on <u>God's Character Alone</u>
THEN IT CAN NEVER CHANGE

& <u>THAT</u> is why we can have great <u>Hope</u> & even <u>Rejoicing</u> <u>THRU</u> & <u>BEYOND</u> - our <u>Suffering</u> Now Paul is going to <u>drive his point home</u> with an <u>argument style</u> the <u>rabbis</u> called "<u>light & heavy</u>"

We call these "<u>If – Then</u>" statements

Paul <u>uses two</u> of these "<u>IF - THEN</u>" statements one in <u>v.9</u>, another in <u>v.10</u>

# Rom 5:9 - ESV

9 <u>Since</u>, therefore, we have now been justified by his blood, (then) much more shall we be saved by him from the wrath of God.

<u>Paul's point</u> is to drive home the <u>Guaranteed</u> - <u>Absolutely Solid</u> <u>Never changing</u> - <u>Love of God</u> toward us

& so he says,

<u>SINCE</u> we have been <u>Justified</u> by the blood of Christ <u>when</u> we were His <u>enemies</u>

**THEN** - How <u>much more</u> will we be <u>saved</u> from the wrath of God, <u>now that</u> we have been made righteous before God (in Christ)

& then Paul turns around & says the same thing again - For Impact

#### Rom 5:10 - ESV

10 For <u>if</u> (SINCE) while we were enemies we were reconciled to God by the death of his Son, (THEN) much more, now that we are reconciled, shall we be saved by his life.

Same argument - For Impact

<u>IF</u> while we were <u>ENEMIES</u> we were <u>Reconciled to God</u> by the <u>death</u> of His own Son

**THEN** how much more, now that we <u>ARE Reconciled</u>, shall we be <u>saved</u> by His life?

#### God is convincing you that

He is <u>WITH YOU</u> in your suffering He is <u>AT WORK</u> in your suffering He will <u>NEVER</u> <u>Leave</u> you - nor <u>Forsake</u> you

He's **proven Himself** to you by *Reconciling* you to *Himself* - **when** you were His **enemy** 

How much more - now that you are <u>His child</u>
will He be sure to <u>carry you</u> thru your <u>suffering</u>?

We're talking about **Rejoicing THRU & BEYOND** our **Suffering** 

& <u>in V. 11</u> - it's like Paul says <u>But really</u>
More than <u>Rejoicing Thru & Beyond</u> our <u>Suffering</u>,

More than focusing on our Trials at all . . . just look at V.11

# **Rom 5:11 - ESV**

11 More than that, we also rejoice in God through our Lord Jesus Christ, through whom we have now <u>received</u> reconciliation.

It's Great to Rejoice THRU & BEYOND our suffering

**But really**, there's a day coming very soon when **you & I** are going to be **Rejoicing** 

in **ONE THING** - & **ONE THING Alone** - & that is;

That we have been Reconciled to God thru faith in Jesus Christ

& when <u>THAT</u> day comes - I promise you
The <u>Full & Eternal Rejoicing</u> - is really going to <u>begin</u> - - <u>AMEN?</u>
