Mrk62 - Courageous Followers - Mark 15:40-47

In our last 2 msg's in Mark

First we asked – <u>Does The Cross MOVE You?</u>

<u>Are you MOVED</u> by the <u>King of Heaven</u>

being **SUBJECTED** to **EVERY TYPE** of **CRUELTY** that our **Sin Nature** could **Muster**

& then – Being Brutally Nailed to the Cross - & left to DIE

THEN we asked - Does the Cross DRAW you?

The <u>agony</u> of <u>every sin</u> of the <u>World</u> <u>falling</u> on <u>Jesus all</u> at <u>once</u>

& the <u>Horror</u> of <u>God in the flesh</u> <u>PAYING</u> the <u>Full Penalty</u> for <u>every one</u> of <u>YOUR</u> Sins - & <u>MINE</u>

<u>Darkness</u> engulfing <u>Calvary</u> - & <u>Jesus crying</u> out "My God, My God WHY have you forsaken me?

& In His AGONY - We asked

Does the Cross DRAW you TO Jesus?

Today we are **faced** with the **question**

<u>TO WHAT EXTENT</u> – <u>have</u> you been <u>MOVED BY</u> - & <u>DRAWN TO</u> – The <u>Savior of the World dying</u> in your <u>place</u> on the <u>cross</u>

& <u>IN RESPONSE</u> – to <u>WHO</u> Jesus <u>IS</u> & <u>WHAT</u> Jesus has <u>DONE</u> for you . . .

What would you be Willing to RISK in this World
To Stand - WITH Jesus - & Take a Stand - FOR Him?

Let's Pray

We <u>left</u> our <u>last msg</u> - with the <u>staggering statement</u> of <u>faith</u> by the <u>Roman Centurion</u> - in <u>charge</u> of the <u>crucifixion</u>

In Mark 15:39 (NLT)

39 When the Roman officer who stood facing him saw how he had died, he exclaimed, "This man truly was the Son of God!"

Doesn't it strike you as ODD

after <u>ALL</u> that <u>Jesus</u> had <u>DONE</u> for his Disciples after <u>ALL</u> the <u>PROOF</u> after <u>ALL</u> the <u>PROPHECY</u>

That the LAST statement made at the cross
About the PROVEN DEITY of Jesus

Was made by the Roman Centurion in charge of killing him?

Where were the Disciples?

WHERE were those who promised to follow him - even to death?

We KNOW why Judas Iscariot wasn't there.

We KNOW Peter was being Crushed under a Mountain of Guilt after DENYING that he even knew Jesus - THREE TIMES

& <u>We KNOW</u> that <u>ONLY</u> the <u>Disciple</u> whom <u>Jesus loved</u> (John) was <u>there</u>

So – that <u>Makes 1 out of 11</u> - who <u>had</u> the <u>COURAGE</u> to <u>STAND for Jesus</u> - on <u>Calvary</u> that <u>day</u>

But – **there** were **others** at the **cross**

Others more Courageous than 10 of the remaining disciples

Others MORE WILLING than TEN of the Disciples

to be **SEEN with Jesus**

to be *NAMED with Jesus*

to **STAND UP for Jesus**

<u>MORE WILLING</u> to <u>LOSE</u> – <u>More Willing</u> to <u>SACRIFICE</u> their <u>lives</u> <u>than TEN</u> of the <u>Original Disciples</u>

& <u>initially</u> – <u>Besides</u> the <u>Apostle John</u> - THEY WERE ALL WOMEN

Mark 15:40 (NLT)

40 Some <u>women</u> were there, watching from a distance, including <u>Mary Magdalene</u>, <u>Mary</u> (the mother of James the younger and of Joseph), and <u>Salome</u>.

1st was Mary Magdalene - from whom Jesus cast out 7 Demons

- & who became a key PART of the Ministry of Jesus
- In <u>LUKE 7</u> An <u>immoral woman</u> <u>knelt</u> at the <u>feet</u> of Jesus & her <u>tears fell</u> on his <u>feet</u>
- & **she wiped** his **feet** with her **hair** & **poured perfume** on his **feet**
- & when Simon the Pharisee condemned Jesus for allowing this to happen

Jesus said to him - in Luke 7:47 (NLT)

47 "I tell you, her sins—and they are many—have been forgiven, so she has shown me much love. But a person who is forgiven little shows only little love."

This MAY well have been Mary Magdalene - Who is now - driven by her Love for Jesus

Risking everything to **be standing** at **the cross** with him

When - 10 of his disciples were too scared to Stand w/ Him

& then – there is *Mary - the mother of <u>James the younger</u>* (Less)

This is awesome

Because James the Younger IS an APOSTLE – he WAS one of the Original 12

BUT – what <u>James the Younger</u> – is <u>known for</u> is his **SERVICE in OBSCURITY**

He is **Just as much** an **Apostle** as **Peter**, **James**, & **John**

But <u>he</u> is <u>only mentioned</u> like <u>FOUR TIMES</u> in the Bible

James the Younger Served the Lord in Obscurity

And –<u>Mary</u> - the mother of James the younger – we <u>also know</u> – <u>almost NOTHING ABOUT</u>

But <u>here</u> – She Is <u>DRIVEN</u> By <u>her Love</u> for <u>Jesus</u>

to **Risk everything** to **Stand up for Jesus** at the **Cross**

& her son, James the Less, ultimately does the same

Giving his life for Jesus without EVER even hardly a MENTION - Anywhere

& <u>Finally</u>, we <u>have Salome</u> – the <u>Mother</u> of the <u>Sons of Thunder</u> - <u>James</u> & <u>John</u>

<u>AND Probably</u> – the <u>SISTER</u> of <u>Mary</u> the <u>Mother</u> of <u>Jesus</u> – & so, <u>She</u> is <u>Jesus' AUNT</u>

Which may help explain why she came to Jesus in MAT 20

& <u>asked</u> if her "<u>Special Boys</u>" (James & John) <u>could sit</u> on <u>Jesus' right</u> & <u>left</u> in his <u>Kingdom</u>

BUT – She is HERE – At the Cross

- & <u>it</u> is her <u>DEEP LOVE</u> for <u>both Jesus</u> & Her <u>sister Mary</u> (mother of Jesus) <u>that</u> has <u>driven</u> her <u>here</u>
- & <u>Mary</u> the <u>Mother of Jesus</u> is <u>here</u> <u>experiencing</u> the <u>agony</u> only <u>a mother</u> can <u>experience</u>

& Mark 15:41 says (NLT)

41 They (these 3 named women) had been followers of Jesus and had cared for him while he was in Galilee. Many other women who had come with him to Jerusalem were also there.

<u>People debate</u> - <u>WHY</u> it was <u>almost</u> <u>all WOMEN</u>
who <u>were</u> at the <u>Cross</u> for <u>Jesus</u>

& <u>some point</u> to <u>Culture Differences</u> – that <u>they say</u> might've <u>made it safer</u> for <u>them</u> to be <u>there</u> than for the <u>men</u>

BUT I DON'T THINK SO

I think the <u>Deep</u> & <u>Sacrificial LOVE</u> that <u>these women</u> had for <u>Jesus *AND*</u> for <u>one another</u>

<u>DROVE</u> them to <u>STAND</u> at the <u>foot</u> of the <u>cross</u> – <u>when ALL But ONE</u> of the <u>Disciples</u> <u>were IN HIDING</u>

But – it's **NOT just** the **Women** and the **Apostle John**Willing to Risk it all to be **Standing For Jesus** – At the Cross

There were TWO MEN – who were definitely Risking IT ALL

to <u>STAND UP</u> for <u>Jesus</u> & <u>TO COME</u> TO <u>Jesus</u> – <u>At the Cross</u>

Even if it meant losing EVERYTHING to do it

Mark 15:42-43 (NLT)

42 This all happened on Friday, the day of preparation, the day before the Sabbath. As evening approached,

43 Joseph of Arimathea took a risk and went to Pilate and asked for Jesus' body. (Joseph was an honored member of the high council, and he was waiting for the Kingdom of God to come.)

By going to PILATE to ask for Jesus' Body to prepare it and place it in HIS OWN TOMB

Joseph of Arimathea was *RISKING the LOSS* of <u>every single thing</u> - <u>important</u> to <u>him</u> in <u>this life</u>

<u>Joseph of Arimathea</u> was an <u>Honored member</u> of the <u>Sanhedrin</u> – the <u>Same Group</u> that <u>had just KILLED Jesus</u>

in V.43 - <u>the NLT</u> says – Joseph <u>Took A Risk</u>
<u>The ESV</u> says – He <u>Took Courage</u>
<u>The NET</u> says – he <u>Went Boldly</u> to Pilate

It took everything he had in him

Because he was Signing his own Death Sentence – as far as being a member of the Sanhedrin goes

He was a Wealthy, Prominent, Honored "Leader of Jewish Society"
Right up - until THIS Moment

Because THIS DECISION - Cost him ALL of THAT

What little we know from legend & story - is that

<u>Joseph of Arimathea</u> was <u>jailed</u> by the <u>Sanhedrin</u> – & <u>Lost everything</u> that <u>went with</u> his <u>honored</u> <u>Sanhedrin life</u>

& he <u>became</u>, (in essence), a <u>Missionary</u> spreading the Good News – of Jesus Christ

After LOSING EVERYTHING - For Jesus

& Our point today is - He was WILLING

He was WILLING to Lose it ALL & he Probably DID - Lose it ALL

Because of his LOVE FOR Jesus & his FAITH IN Jesus

ALL that he <u>had Gained</u> in this <u>World</u>
He COUNTED as LOSS – And he *DID LOSE*

In order to put on PUBLIC DISPLAY
His Faith & Love for His SAVIOR

<u>Including placing Jesus</u> in his own <u>Costly</u> - <u>Never Used</u>, <u>TOMB</u>

And - Joseph of Arimathea wasn't ALONE

He **had** another **Courageous Follower** with **him**

Who also was willing to RISK Everything
To Take a Stand for Jesus – at the cross

So - v.43 says Joseph of Arimathea COURAGEOUSLY went to Pilate to ask for Jesus' body

& then we read in Mark 15:44-45 (NLT)

44 Pilate couldn't believe that Jesus was already dead, so he called for the Roman officer and asked if he had died yet.
45 The officer confirmed that Jesus was dead, so Pilate told Joseph he could have the body.

Now - this word - is going to Spread FAST

<u>That</u> a <u>member</u> of the <u>Sanhedrin</u> is <u>caring</u> for the <u>body of Jesus</u> – <u>who</u> the <u>Sanhedrin</u> just <u>had MURDERED</u>

That's not gonna go well for Joseph of Arimathea

Life as he knew it - WAS OVER at this minute

BUT – he had a COURAGEOUS Co-Follower
Who was also ready - to lose everything for Jesus

(over in) John 19:38–39 (NLT) – (I Love This)

38 Afterward Joseph of Arimathea, who HAD BEEN a secret disciple of Jesus (because he feared the Jewish leaders)

(He <u>HAD BEEN</u> a secret Disciple – but NO MORE – he is now laying it all on the line - AND losing it all, for Jesus),

(Joseph) asked Pilate for permission to take down Jesus' body. When Pilate gave permission, Joseph came and took the body away.

39 <u>With him came Nicodemus</u>, the man who had come to Jesus at night.

(Nicodemus is no longer "Nic at Night") (Ol' Nic is out in the open now, & he will also, most likely, lose everything for it)

He brought about seventy-five pounds of perfumed ointment made from myrrh and aloes.

(meaning <u>Nicodemus</u> was ALSO wealthy *AND* a *Newly Courageous Follower*)

These are Two HIGH-POWERED, Well Positioned people

Who are BOTH putting it all on the line - FOR JESUS

<u>They</u> are <u>right now</u> – <u>telling</u> their <u>World</u> – in a <u>VERY LOUD Way</u>
<u>That they</u> are <u>Followers of Jesus Christ</u>

Like Joseph of Arimathea Nicodemus was ALSO on the Sanhedrin

He **ALSO** was **living** – the **honorable HIGH-LIFE**

But - in this moment

they are both willing to Lose Everything
in order to show their Love & Commitment to Jesus

<u>& so, we finish in Mark 15:46–47 (NLT)</u>

46 Joseph bought a long sheet of linen cloth. Then he (with Nicodemus) took Jesus' body down from the cross, wrapped it in the cloth, and laid it in a tomb that had been carved out of the rock. Then he rolled a stone in front of the entrance.

47 Mary Magdalene and Mary the mother of Joseph saw where Jesus' body was laid.

So . . . ALL the Shock & Pain & Horror of the Crucifixion was OVER

The <u>currently lifeless body</u> of <u>Jesus</u> was <u>left hanging</u> on the <u>cross</u>

<u>Maybe Mary Magdalene</u> & <u>Mary</u> the <u>mother of Joseph</u> were the <u>only two</u> followers <u>left</u>

because they were frozen, in shock
still there only because they couldn't move

BUT - Where are the Disciples?

<u>Do we</u> give <u>them</u> a <u>PASS</u> here?
<u>Do we</u> say, <u>well they</u> were <u>AFRAID</u>, so <u>we understand</u>?

What about the Wealthy Sadducee & Wealthy Pharisee?

Both members of the Jewish High Council & Both at the Pinnacle of Jewish Society

Didn't THEY have **something** to **be afraid** of?

They actually had a TON MORE to Lose than the disciples did

But <u>THERE THEY ARE</u> – <u>Racing</u> to have <u>Jesus</u> in <u>Joseph's own tomb</u> before <u>sunset</u>

(& the beginning of the High Holy Sabbath)

They both would be **DEFILED** by touching a dead body

They both would be **BARRED** from family & friends on that Sabbath

& <u>if</u> the <u>early church writings</u> are <u>true</u>
They both <u>GAVE UP EVERYTHING</u> they <u>had</u> in this <u>world</u>

In order to STAND UP for Jesus
When even his own disciples - WOULD NOT

The women at the cross that day & these Two Jewish Sanhedrin Members

THEY were the COURAGEOUS FOLLOWERS that day

Because they were the only ones who had THE COURAGE

- to Stand WITH Jesus
- to Stand FOR Jesus
- AND to **Suffer The Loss** of **everything** they **had** in this **world**
- In <u>order</u> to <u>show</u> their <u>Devotion</u> <u>TO Jesus</u>

What about US?

Where are we in this picture?

<u>ARE WE huddled</u> in the <u>upper room</u> – <u>Whispering</u> so <u>no one</u> will <u>hear us</u>?

HAVE WE gone back to the Garden of Gethsemane – Hoping that no one will find us?

ARE WE following Peter's Lead -

& **Denying** that we **even KNOW** that **man hanging** on **the cross**?

ARE WE afraid of losing something in this Life By Taking A Stand for Jesus?

ARE WE worried that we'll lose our reputation
That we'll lose our friends – or even our family

By SHOWING our Love & Devotion for Jesus?

How could the <u>Disciples</u> be <u>afraid</u> they were going to *lose ANYTHING*?

What - in this World,
could be WORTH Abandoning Jesus for?

The <u>Apostle Paul</u> is <u>talking about</u>
all the <u>things</u> of this <u>world</u> - <u>when</u> he <u>says</u> in

Philippians 3:7-9 (NLT)

7 I once thought these things were valuable, but now I consider them <u>worthless</u> because of what Christ has done.

8 Yes, <u>everything else is worthless</u> when compared with the infinite value of knowing Christ Jesus my Lord. For his sake I have <u>discarded</u> everything else, counting it all as <u>garbage</u>, so that I could gain Christ <u>9</u> and become one with him . . .

The ONLY Reason – We have to FEAR

Being an OUT-SPOKEN Christ-Follower

Is **because** we **think** there is **SOMETHING** in **This Life that** has **MORE WORTH** – than **knowing Jesus**

<u>BUT</u> – <u>When</u> we <u>understand</u> – <u>that everything else is worthless</u> when compared with the infinite value of knowing Christ Jesus

THEN we Will Become - COURAGEOUS FOLLOWERS
