ROM 210 - Living in Adam or Living in Christ - Rom 5:12-21

We are on "The Bridge" right now between the 1st part of Paul's letter & the 2nd part - that we're about to "dive into" in the next 3 Ch's

After seeing God's perfect judgment in the first msgs
We then saw the miracle of justification by faith in last few msgs

Now - Paul is about to take us from *justification* to *sanctification* - in the *next 3 Ch's*

God wants to do more than **declare** a believer <u>righteous</u> (Justification) He wants to **transform** each of our <u>lives</u> (Sanctification)

But before we can go on to <u>sanctification</u> (transformation of our lives)
Paul <u>wants to insure</u> that we've <u>graduated</u> from <u>Salvation 101</u>

So he <u>nails down</u>, in today's text the <u>very heart</u> of the <u>Theology of God</u>

We <u>cannot advance</u> in our <u>Life with God</u> until **this truth** is rock solid in our minds

<u>Today</u> - what we <u>really need</u> to <u>Understand</u> is the <u>Theology</u> of <u>FEDERAL HEADSHIP</u>

There is a <u>Federal headship</u> of <u>Adam</u> - & <u>There is</u> a <u>Federal headship</u> of <u>Jesus Christ</u> . . .

& <u>every</u> single <u>one</u> of us is living under either <u>ONE</u> or the <u>OTHER</u> <u>Federal Head</u>

Let's Pray

The Bible is very clear - about what <u>theologians</u> call the "<u>Federal Headship</u>" of <u>Adam</u> - & of <u>Christ</u>

From God's perspective

Adam is the <u>head</u> of all <u>physical</u> humanity Jesus Christ is the <u>head</u> of all **spiritual** humanity

AND So - because of that . . .

Our <u>Sin Nature</u> comes to us solely <u>THRU</u> <u>Adam</u>, <u>and</u> Our <u>New Nature</u> comes to us solely <u>THRU</u> <u>Jesus Christ</u>

Rom 5:18-19 is a summary of this great truth (let's read the NLT)

Rom 5:18-19 - NLT

18 Yes, Adam's one sin brings condemnation for everyone, but Christ's one act of righteousness brings a right relationship with God and new life for everyone.

19 Because one person disobeyed God, many became sinners. But because one other person obeyed God, many will be made righteous.

This is known as the "Federal Headship" of Adam & of Christ & it's important we see it before we move into Sanctification

We must come to <u>realize</u> that we are <u>Truly One</u> (United) with <u>Jesus Christ</u> - - <u>but first</u> . . .

We must come to <u>realize</u> that we are <u>Truly One</u> (United) initially with <u>Adam</u>

<u>Thru Oneness</u> with <u>Adam</u> we are partakers of <u>sin & death</u> <u>Thru Oneness</u> with <u>Christ</u> we are partakers of <u>righteousness & life</u> The reason that's so important is

<u>Understanding</u> that our <u>Sin Nature</u> comes <u>THRU Adam</u> . . .

Is **the basis** for understanding that our *Righteousness* comes **THRU CHRIST**

That is actually **the core** of the salvation message

We are "By Nature" united with Adam - in Sin & Death

& so we <u>MUST</u> (by receiving a <u>New Nature</u>) be <u>united with Jesus Christ</u> - in <u>Righteousness & Life</u>

& Every Single one of us must make that choice . . .

To either <u>remain</u> <u>Living in Adam</u>, or to be <u>transformed</u> by <u>Living in Christ</u>

& <u>IN</u> <u>that choice</u> - is not only <u>salvation</u>
but is <u>also</u> - the beginning of <u>understanding</u>
of <u>HOW to live</u> - our <u>New Life in Christ</u>

Alright - Ro 5:12 starts with "The Federal Headship of Adam"

& In this <u>1st Vs</u>. - Paul <u>starts</u> a thought that he <u>doesn't really finish</u> until <u>V.18</u>

Rom 5:12 - ESV \rightarrow \rightarrow

Rom 5:12 - ESV

12 Therefore, just as sin came into the world through one man, and death through sin, and so death spread to all men because all sinned—

<u>Paul starts</u> with The Fall of <u>Adam</u> that <u>caused sin and death</u> to spread to <u>every</u> human being

Adam was the "Federal Head" of All Mankind

& because <u>Adam</u> represented <u>ALL</u> mankind - his <u>one act of rebellion</u> - <u>allowed sin</u> to permeate the entire <u>realm of humanity</u>

Again V.12 says;

sin came into the world through one man, and death through sin,

But then <u>notice carefully</u> - it says; and so death spread to all men <u>because all sinned</u>

The words – "<u>all sinned</u>" – are in the <u>Greek</u> <u>aorist tense</u>, which, in it's <u>simple definition</u>, means to us "<u>past tense</u>"

because ALL sinned - is not talking about past sins in our lives

it's talking about a Much More Important point

Here's the point - - & it's <u>very important</u> to <u>understand</u> our Salvation <u>IN CHRIST</u> . . .

Adam represented all mankind, & so
 when <u>Adam</u> sinned – each <u>one of us</u> sinned "<u>in Adam</u>"
 THAT'S why it says - because all sinned - - IN ADAM

Because <u>Adam</u> was our <u>Federal Head</u>, It was as if <u>all of Mankind</u> was there with him

& the <u>root of sin</u> was <u>transmitted</u> to <u>every member</u> of the human race

<u>That</u> is called the <u>Federal Headship</u> of Adam for all humanity

As Adam sinned (as our federal head) - We sinned "IN" Adam

That is a solid Biblical Truth that must be grasped in order to understand HOW God's theology works

Adam's <u>sin NATURE</u> has been <u>passed down</u> to <u>every person</u> that's ever lived

but <u>ALSO</u> (because of that sin nature),

<u>every person</u> who has <u>ever lived</u> (except Christ)
has <u>ACTED</u> on (& in) that <u>sin nature</u>

Rom 3:23 - ESV

23 for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God,

Nobody is "<u>Left Out</u>" - <u>ALL</u> have sinned <u>both</u> "<u>In Adam</u>" & in <u>our own actions</u> But <u>we didn't even know</u> how <u>lost in Sin</u> we were until God's Law <u>showed us</u> - our <u>Great Lostness</u>

Rom 5:13-14 - ESV

13 for sin indeed was in the world before the law was given, but sin is not counted where there is no law.

14 Yet death reigned from Adam to Moses (the proof of sin), even over those whose sinning was not like the transgression of Adam, who was a type of the one who was to come.

Since the moment of Adam's fall

Sin, Death, & Separation from God has been engrained in man's "Fallen Nature"

The effects of <u>Adam's Sin</u> has always been <u>carried by mankind</u>
But <u>God's Law</u> was needed
to <u>Shine a Light</u> on the <u>True Sinfulness</u> of that <u>Sin Nature</u>

God's Law <u>reveals</u> our sin to us Like a **Huge Light** in a Dark Pit

So - Thru God's Law - we are FORCED to acknowledge our union with 'Adam's Sin'

& God's Law <u>FORCES</u> us to <u>acknowledge our need</u> for a <u>Remedy OUTSIDE</u> of that <u>Sin Nature</u> we share with Adam

But - it was Not the law - that BROUGHT the consequence of Sin

The consequence of Sin is **Death**

& <u>Death had reigned</u> in mankind - from <u>Adam</u> to <u>Moses</u>

Just as V.14 says; $\rightarrow \rightarrow$

Rom 5:14A - ESV

14 Yet death reigned from Adam to Moses, even over those whose sinning was not like the transgression of Adam . . .

The consequence of Death - is the proof that Sin permeated ALL mankind

even those whose sin was not "Specifically" like Adam's

meaning - those who did not <u>specifically disobey</u> a <u>direct command</u> from God

The point is - <u>Sin</u> (& the resulting <u>Death</u>) permeated all mankind because of <u>Adam's Federal Headship</u>

& what we need to see is;

THAT is actually the foundation of <u>HOW</u> we are <u>saved</u> by the <u>Actions of ONE MAN</u> (Jesus Christ)

Just as we are **CONDEMNED** by the actions of a <u>Federal Head</u>
We are also **SAVED** by the actions of a <u>Federal Head</u>

& <u>THAT truth</u> is <u>referred to</u> at the end of <u>V.14</u>
... Adam, who was a type of the one who was to come.

I really like the way **The Message Paraphrase** puts this sentence

V.14C - The Message

But Adam, who got us into this, also points ahead to the One who will get us out of it.

Isn't that just like God?

Right in the Tragedy of the Fall of Man is actually a Picture of God's Great Plan of Salvation

The **theology of God**

that caused each of us to be sinners "in Adam"

is the same theology of God

that allows each of us to be made *righteous* "in Christ"

Both Adam & Christ hold "Federal Headship" positions
because both of their actions
caused eternal consequences for all mankind

one - a consequence of DEATH, &

one - a consequence of LIFE

<u>& again</u> - understanding <u>HOW</u> <u>Adam's</u> sin <u>brought death to us</u> - - is actually <u>the foundation</u>

for understanding <u>HOW</u> the sacrifice of <u>Jesus Christ</u> brings Salvation to us

Because in the same way that death was passed to all humanity because of the sin of one man . . .

In that same way - <u>Eternal Life</u> is passed to all who believe because of the <u>righteous act</u> of one man – Jesus Christ !!

1Cor 15:21-22 - ESV \rightarrow \rightarrow

1Cor 15:21-22 - NLT

21 So you see, <u>just as</u> death came into the world through <u>a</u> <u>man</u>, now the resurrection from the dead has begun through another man.

22 Just as everyone dies because we all belong to Adam, everyone who belongs to Christ will be given new life.

Do you see it? Isn't it Incredible?

The <u>Theology of God</u> remains <u>the SAME</u> whether it's <u>Judgment upon sin</u> leading to <u>Death</u> - or whether is <u>Justification in Christ</u> - leading to <u>Life</u>

Either way - God remains TRUE to Himself

But here's the really good news

the work of the <u>last Adam</u> (Christ) is <u>immeasurably greater</u> than the <u>1st Adam</u>

So - let's try to compare living in Adam and living in Christ

Rom 5:15 - ESV

15 But the free gift is not like the trespass. For if many died through one man's trespass, <u>much more</u> have the grace of God and the free gift by the grace of that one man Jesus Christ abounded for many.

The sin of Adam brought death,

But the 'much more' grace of God has brought . . .

the 'much more' dynamic power - of Eternal & Abundant Life
by the Grace of that one Man - Jesus Christ

Because the <u>life we receive</u> when we make <u>Jesus Christ</u> our <u>Federal Head</u> . . .

not only overcomes death,

but it <u>restores</u> **ALL** that the <u>Sin Nature</u> had <u>destroyed</u>

That's why Paul says in V.15

much more have the grace of God and the free gift by that grace - abounded for many

Now - Don't get hung up on that word 'many' there in V.15

it <u>literally</u> is "the many" meaning "The Number Effected" by the <u>One Act</u>

In regard to Adam:

"The Many" - are ALL who are ever PHYSICALLY BORN

in regard to Jesus Christ:

"The Many" - are ALL who are ever SPIRITUALLY BORN-AGAIN

Paul's **point** here is to **contrast** the *two headships* & he continues that *Contrast* - in **V.16**

allow me to **read it** from the **NLT**

Rom 5:16 - NLT \rightarrow \rightarrow

Rom 5:16 - **NLT**

16 And the result of God's gracious gift is very different from the result of that one man's sin. For Adam's sin led to condemnation, but God's free gift leads to our being made right with God, even though we are guilty of many sins.

Adam's one sin

brought the **certainty of death** to **every person**

Jesus' one sacrifice

brings the availability of eternal life to every person

Simply put:

Living '<u>in Adam</u>' results in <u>condemnation</u> before God Living '<u>in Christ</u>' results in <u>justification</u> (being made right) with God

Again - in **V. 17** - we see;

the **Contrast of Sin** with the **MUCH MORE Grace** of God

Rom 5:17 - (back to) ESV

17 <u>If</u>, because of one man's trespass, death reigned through that one man, <u>much more</u> will those who receive the abundance of grace and the free gift of righteousness reign in life through the one man Jesus Christ.

Through Adam death reigned

and it still does reign for those living 'in Adam'

But much more;

in the <u>Abundance of Grace</u> & in the <u>Free Gift of Righteousness</u> will we **reign in life** through the one man - Jesus Christ!

& It is this same "much more" grace of God that is BOTH;

God's <u>remedy</u> to forgive sin - <u>AND</u> God's <u>method</u> to transform the sinner (start to see that next week)

& **the blessings** that come from living in that 'much more', super-abundant grace of God

are greater than we can ever really even imagine with its <u>ultimate result</u> being

Eternal Life for us - as Joint-heirs with Jesus Christ

Now, <u>let's reread</u> the summary <u>verses</u> we started with (<u>Vs's18 & 19</u>)

Remember - Each One of us is in one of two places today

<u>Either</u> we are Living "<u>in Adam</u>" – under <u>Adam's</u> headship . . . or, we are Living "<u>in Christ</u>" – under <u>Christ's</u> headship

& from <u>God's Perspective</u> - It is either <u>ONE</u> or the <u>OTHER</u> there is **NO** in-between

We are either IN ADAM - or we are IN CHRIST

Rom 5:18-19 - ESV \rightarrow \rightarrow

Rom 5:18-19 - ESV

18 Therefore, as one trespass led to condemnation for all men, so one act of righteousness leads to justification and life for all men.

19 For as by the one man's disobedience the many were made sinners, so by the one man's obedience the many will be made righteous.

<u>I pray today</u> - that you will <u>know For Sure</u> <u>which side</u> of this line you are Living On

<u>Adam</u> is head of all <u>born humanity</u> you come under <u>Adam's</u> <u>headship</u> - when you are <u>physically born</u>

<u>Christ</u> is head of all <u>spiritual humanity</u> you come under <u>Christ's</u> headship - when you are <u>born again</u>

<u>SO</u> - <u>Are you</u> living under "<u>Adam's Headship</u>", or <u>Are you</u> living under "<u>Christ's Headship</u>"

Adam acted on our behalf,
& when Adam Sinned, we sinned "in Adam",

In the same way - Jesus Christ acted on our behalf
& when Jesus conquered Sin, & Death, & the Grave . . .

We who are "In Christ"

Conquered Sin, & Death, & the Grave "IN CHRIST"

That is **God's theology**

& it is **the only way** we can **stand righteous** before God & it's **the only way** we can **Live for God** in this Life

Every **UNBELIEVER** will stand before God "<u>in Adam</u>" as their head

& the <u>Sin Nature</u> that <u>Adam</u> brought upon us, & the sinful acts they committed in that Sin Nature, <u>will be charged</u> against them

But every **BELIEVER** will stand before God "In Christ" as their head

& the <u>Victory that Christ won</u> over <u>Sin</u>, <u>Death</u> & the <u>Grave</u> will be <u>Fully & Completely</u> <u>Attributed</u> to them "<u>In Christ</u>"

So - we see the <u>greatness of our lost-ness</u> thru our unity with <u>Adam</u>

But 'much more' we see the *greatness of our salvation* thru our unity with **Jesus Christ**

Now - All this would certainly come as a <u>SHOCK</u> to Paul's <u>Jewish Readers</u> in Rome

Who felt that everything about God revolved around the Law

But now <u>Paul's saying</u> that <u>Sin & Salvation</u> <u>DO NOT</u> revolve around the <u>LAW</u>

but they Revolve around TWO Federal Heads (Adam & Christ)

& <u>not only that</u> - but Paul's saying the Law was <u>NOT Actually Meant</u> to <u>Save</u> anybody

But was **actually meant** as a **MIRROR**

to show us our **Great NEED** to be <u>Saved</u> & our **inability** to <u>Save Ourselves</u>

So - anticipating this concern

Paul is going to close - w/ a final explanation of the LAW

Rom 5:20 - ESV

20 Now the law came in to increase the trespass, but where sin increased, grace abounded all the more,

The law came in - to <u>reveal</u> the <u>sinfulness of our sin</u>, or as <u>V.20</u> says - to increase the trespass

But where the "Knowledge of Sin" increased
Grace abounded all the more

Look at how the **NLT** puts **Rom 5:20**

Rom 5:20 - **NLT**

20 God's law was given so that all people could see how sinful they were. But as people sinned more and more, God's wonderful grace became more abundant.

ACTUALLY - as the **KNOWLEDGE** of SIN Increased,

the Wonderful Grace of God

became much more ABUNDANTLY APPARENT

That's why Paul says victoriously at the end of V.20 - ESV but where sin increased, grace abounded all the more

The words <u>abounded all the more</u> - are difficult to translate in English, It means Grace "<u>super-increased</u>" or "<u>super-abounded</u>"

It pictures a <u>never-ending</u>, <u>overflowing grace</u>
It is a grace that <u>knows no bounds</u>

The power of God's *grace* - is always *infinitely more abundant* than the power of *sin* will ever be

At the PASSION LA event last weekend

we heard the story of the <u>Title song</u> of the New <u>Passion CD</u> called "<u>God of this City</u>"

It came from a Belfast Worship Band called **BLUETREE** who found themselves playing in a **Brothel** in (I believe) *Panay Philippines*

This city boasts <u>30,000</u> legal prostitutes <u>over 18</u> & an <u>innumerable #</u> of legal prostitutes <u>UNDER 18</u>

& as they played - in one of the Darkest Cities in the World
A city filled with <u>bondage</u>, <u>oppression</u>,
& widespread celebrated <u>legal prostitution</u> of <u>ALL ages</u>

As they played - <u>Right in the middle</u> of <u>unbelievable sin</u> <u>Right in the middle</u> of a full on <u>BROTHEL</u>

God gave them this song
Right in the midst of a mountain of Reprehensible Sin

The song is called "God of this City" & it goes like this;

You're the God of this City

You're the King of these People

You're the Lord of this Nation

You're the Light in this Darkness

You're the <u>Hope</u> to the <u>Hopeless</u>

You're the <u>Peace</u> to the <u>Restless</u>

There is no one like our God

For greater things have yet to come

And greater things are still to be done in this City

You see - As Rom 5:20 says - ESV

20 . . . but where sin increased, grace abounded all the more,

<u>God's Grace</u> "<u>Super-Increased</u>" - it - "<u>Super-Abounded</u>"

There's always 'much more' of God's Super-Abounding GRACE

No matter how grave your sin

God's '<u>much more' grace</u> can be <u>super-abundantly</u> poured out to you.

No one is beyond the reach of God's 'much more' Grace found in Jesus Christ

WHY ??

Why does God <u>ALWAYS</u> have <u>Much More Grace ??</u>

Rom 5:21 - **NLT**

21 So just as sin ruled over all people and brought them to death, now God's wonderful grace rules instead, giving us right standing with God and resulting in eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord.

The ONLY question is:

WHO is Ruling over you today ??

Are you living under the <u>headship of Adam</u> today headed toward certain <u>death</u>?

or <u>are you living</u> under the <u>headship of Christ</u> today headed toward certain **Abundant & Eternal Life**?

You were **BORN** under the *headship of Adam*

Today, you can be BORN-AGAIN
Under the <u>headship of Jesus Christ</u>
