Giv03 - The Blessing of Brokenness - Psalm 51

<u>Last week</u> - in the msg titled "<u>Brokenness</u>"

We said **Brokenness** was a "**Condition of the Heart**" & so can be **defined** in a **number of ways**

today I want to talk about a <u>HEART Condition</u> of Being <u>Broken over our SIN</u>

Of this "Brokenness - One writer said:

Brokenness is the on-ramp to the road of Repentance

Another said: Brokenness is coming to the end of our self-life & recognizing our only hope is in the Grace & Mercy of God

Jesus reserved the 1st Beatitude for the BLESSING of Brokenness

Matthew 5:3 (ESV)

3 "Blessed are the poor in spirit (broken over their sin), for theirs is the kingdom of heaven.

The **BLESSING** of **BROKENNESS** Is **what** I'd **like to talk about** today

Let's Pray

<u>Today</u>, I'd like to go thru <u>Psalm 51</u> - in the context of <u>Brokenness</u>

There are <u>other things</u> that can be <u>studied</u> in <u>Psalm 51</u> (& should be) But <u>today</u> - the <u>Focus</u> is - <u>BROKENNESS</u>

At least a YEAR *Prior* to David writing Psalm 51

He had committed TWO Sins (Adultery & Murder) - For which there was NO ATONEMENT in the Law

- & <u>for a YEAR</u> David had been <u>Living</u> under the <u>Weight</u> of His <u>GUILT</u> While he was <u>COVERING his sin</u> with his PRIDE
- <u>Until</u> one day the <u>Holy Spirit</u> Thru a <u>Prophet</u> named <u>NATHAN</u> <u>CALLED David</u> on his sin - in a very <u>POWERFUL way</u>
- & **Finally** . . . **Finally Psalm 51** is David's **BREAKING** His **Repentance** & his **Restoration** to God

<u>Psalm 51</u> was written - out of David <u>KNOWING</u> - His <u>ONLY HOPE</u> - was in his <u>BROKENNESS</u> before the Lord

We're going to go thru ALMOST ALL of Psalm 51

- & <u>again</u> I'm <u>ROUGHLY</u> using <u>Damian Kyle's OUTLINE</u> (approach) with <u>my own expressions</u> & <u>illustrations</u>
- & I <u>do that</u> really as an <u>acknowledgement</u> of <u>how much</u> <u>Damian Kyle</u> has <u>taught me</u> on this subject

(I was w/ him this week - but didn't get the chance to share)

So - Let's <u>look</u> at the <u>BLESSINGS</u> that **Brokenness Brings** into our **LIVES** - *Thru Psalm 51*

In v.1 - Brokenness Brings us back to a FULL RELIANCE on God's Grace & Mercy - ALONE

Psalm 51:1 (ESV)

1 Have mercy on me, O God, according to your steadfast love; according to your abundant mercy blot out my transgressions.

Brokenness Brings us back to a FULL RELIANCE on God's Grace & Mercy - ALONE

David had committed sins for which there was NO ATONEMENT
There was No Provision in the Law
To Cover Over (atone) for these sins

That <u>means</u> there was <u>nothing DAVID</u> could <u>DO</u> on his <u>own</u> to be <u>made right</u> with God

His <u>Absolute ONLY Hope</u> was - to <u>throw himself</u> completely on God's <u>MERCY</u> - & <u>God's Steadfast Love</u> (His *Hesed*)

& it is **SO EASY** for us to **move away** from a **Real Acknowledgement** of our **constant NEED** for God's **Grace** & **Mercy**

We <u>start thinking</u> we're "Alright" - We're doing "Pretty Good" - "I think God's pretty happy with me"

& we **So Easily begin** to forget that w/o God's Constant GRACE - we would be Helpless, Hopeless, & only under God's Judgment

The BLESSING of Brokenness Brings us back to a FULL RELIANCE on God's Grace & Mercy - ALONE

In v.2 - Brokenness gives us a Constant Desire to Live a PURIFIED LIFE

Psalm 51:2 (ESV)

2 Wash me thoroughly from my iniquity, and cleanse me from my sin!

It's **so easy** for us to begin to **accept Un-holy thinking** - **Un-holy attitudes** - & **Un-holy actions** -

But <u>The BLESSING of Brokenness</u> gives us a Constant Desire to be <u>WASHED</u> from our <u>Iniquity</u> - to <u>Cleansed</u> from our <u>Sin</u>

& <u>please</u> hear me - - <u>PRIDE</u> is the Opposite of <u>Brokenness</u> & <u>PRIDE</u> - keeps us <u>BLIND</u> to the <u>un-holy areas</u> of our life

Brokenness - gives us a **Constant Desire** to live a **PURIFIED** Life - **Cleansed** from Sin

PRIDE - gives us a <u>REASON</u> - & a <u>METHOD</u> - to <u>cover up</u> & <u>deny</u> the <u>Unholy areas</u> of our lives - <u>leading</u> to our <u>destruction</u>

Brokenness KEEPS us in the TRANSFORMATION Process - Because it gives us a Constant Desire to Live a PURIFIED LIFE

In v.3 - Brokenness brings a HUMILITY that allows me to admit when I'm WRONG

Psalm 51:3 (ESV)

3 For I know my transgressions, and my sin is ever before me.

Have <u>you ever</u> had the <u>difficult experience</u> of <u>interacting</u> with <u>someone</u> who is <u>ALWAYS RIGHT</u> (in their own eyes)?

That **comes** from **HIGH Pride** & **LOW Brokenness**

But Brokenness allows me to quickly admit when I'm wrong

In Fact <u>Brokenness</u> causes me to <u>admit</u>
I <u>MAY very well be wrong</u> & <u>not even know</u> it -

It is so **FREEING** to be a **Sinner Saved** by **GRACE**

- & to <u>have</u> the <u>HUMILITY</u> to <u>know</u> at any <u>given moment</u> I <u>may</u> be <u>wrong</u> & <u>may</u> even be <u>operating</u> in a <u>sinful state</u>
- & if that **sounds WRONG** to you you **may want** to take my #1 **Pride test**

My #1 Pride test is a simple question - "How often are you RIGHT?"

& the <u>MORE OFTEN</u> you're <u>RIGHT</u> - <u>the more</u> you <u>may</u> truly <u>need</u> the <u>Blessing of Brokenness</u> in <u>your life</u>

In v. 4 - Brokenness allows us to Understand, & Admit, the True Impact of our Sin

Psalm 51:4 (ESV)

4 Against you, you only, have I sinned and done what is evil in your sight, so that you may be justified in your words and blameless in your judgment.

Brokenness brings a Deep **REMORSE** - for **what** I've **done to God** - & what **I've done** to **HIS Name**

God, this is against YOU, that I've done this I've belittled your name - I've sinned against YOU

Brokenness is not **REGRETTING** the **Consequences** of your **Sin** It's **understanding** the **TRUE IMPACT** of your Sin - **Eternally**

It's **interesting** - to **COMPARE** how **David** got taken down by his **sin with Bathsheba**

to how **JOSEPH** handled a **similar situation** with **Potiphar's** wife - in **Gen Ch 39**

David had plenty of warnings as he plowed forward into his sin -

But David **justified**, **rationalized**, & **schemed**- **ALL** signs of **SELF-Centered Pride**

<u>Joseph</u> (on the other hand) - <u>Said</u> to <u>Potiphar's</u> wife - when **SHE** was **trying** to get **Joseph** to commit the **SAME Sin** . . .

In Genesis 39:9 - Joseph told Potiphar's wife (ESV)
9 . . . How then can I do this great wickedness and sin against God?"

How can I do this <u>TO GOD</u> - & <u>DRAG</u> God's <u>name</u> thru <u>the mud</u> like that

Brokenness allows us to **Understand**, & **Admit**, the **True Impact** of our Sin

In v.5 - Brokenness gives us a CORRECT VIEW of our OWN Sin Nature

Psalm 51:5 (ESV)

5 Behold, I was brought forth in iniquity, and in sin did my mother conceive me.

I was <u>BORN</u> a <u>SINNER</u>
I <u>LIVED</u> as a <u>SINNER</u> - <u>BEFORE</u> I was Saved
I've been at <u>WAR</u> with Sin - <u>SINCE</u> I've been Saved

Paul had this SAME Understanding in Romans 7:18 (NLT)

18 And I know that nothing good lives in me, that is, in my sinful nature . . .

<u>Paul</u> goes on to say in <u>v.24</u> - *Oh, wretched man that I am - who will Deliver me from this body of Death*

Brokenness gives us a CORRECT VIEW of our OWN Sin Nature - & it - is - UGLY

But notice in v.6 - Brokenness brings us back to TRUTH & WISDOM from God

Psalm 51:6 (ESV)

6 Behold, you delight in truth in the inward being, and you teach me wisdom in the secret heart.

True **Brokenness** - Keeps us **HONEST** & **TRUTHFUL** with God Enabling Him to **Teach** us, & **Transform** us

David had been living this crazy LIE for a YEAR - Before God

in his Pride - David thought he couldcontinue living with God without dealing with His sin

But **Brokenness freed him** from that **crazy Lie**

Brokenness keeps SHORT accounts with God

But Pride causes us to try to sweep sin under the rug thinking maybe God won't LOOK there

<u>In fact</u> - <u>Just like</u> there are <u>tests for Pride</u> there are <u>similar tests</u> for <u>Brokenness</u>

One sure-fire test is the amount of time between your sin & your repentance - both to God & to another person if necessary

The longer we struggle with confessing our sin & repenting of it - the further away from Brokenness we are

Brokenness lives in TRUTH - at the CORE of who we are

- & **BECAUSE** of **Living** in that **Truth** (v.6 also says) **Brokenness brings** the **wisdom of God Alive in my heart** again
- In **Brokenness** God can **teach you** -
- in PRIDE You are a very POOR Student

Brokenness brings us back - to TRUTH & WISDOM from God

Then - In v. 7-8 - Brokenness brings a return of JOY & GLADNESS to our lives

Psalm 51:7-8 (ESV)

7 Purge me with hyssop, and I shall be clean; wash me, and I shall be whiter than snow.

8 Let me hear joy and gladness; let the bones that you have broken rejoice.

<u>David</u> says "<u>Purge me with Hyssop</u>" - which was <u>the branch</u> used to <u>sprinkle</u> the <u>BLOOD</u> of Atonement

<u>David</u> is <u>saying</u> - "Purge me with THE BLOOD" & I shall be clean - WASH me (again implying blood) & I shall be whiter than snow

In his <u>Brokenness</u> - <u>David</u> wanted <u>SO BAD</u> to be <u>returned</u> to the <u>Joy & Gladness</u> of his <u>salvation</u> in the Lord

His life had been SO DRY -

Separated from the Lord by his SIN - He had lost all his Joy

When were <u>carrying</u> the <u>WEIGHT</u> of our sin - We are <u>CRUSHED</u> under it - it is constantly <u>SUFFOCATING</u> us

After David's Confession & Repentance in Psalm 51 - Looking back on the crushing burden of his unrepentant sin . . .

He wrote **Psalm 32 -** is called a "**Psalm of Instruction**"

Psalm 32:1-5 (NLT)

- 1 Oh, what joy for those whose disobedience is forgiven, whose sin is put out of sight!
- 2 Yes, what joy for those whose record the Lord has cleared of guilt, whose lives are lived in complete honesty!
- 3 When I refused to confess my sin, my body wasted away, and I groaned all day long.

4 Day and night your hand of discipline was heavy on me. My strength evaporated like water in the summer heat.
5 Finally, I confessed all my sins to you and stopped trying to hide my guilt. I said to myself, "I will confess my rebellion to the Lord." And you forgave me! All my guilt is gone.

That is **SUCH** a **GREAT 5 Vs's** - **May we ALL** be able to **say exactly That** with David

When I confessed my sin to you, Lord, and stopped trying to hide my guilt - You FORGAVE me! & All my guilt is GONE!!

<u>Augustine</u> said of this Psalm "The beginning of knowledge is to know oneself to be a sinner"

Brokenness DOES that

THRU Brokenness - God Forgives, & God brings a Return of JOY & GLADNESS to our lives

v.9 Closes David's Acknowledgement, & SHAME, of his sin

Psalm 51:9 (ESV)

9 Hide your face from my sins, and blot out all my iniquities.

<u>David</u> was <u>ashamed</u> to have <u>God look upon</u> his sin His <u>BROKENNESS</u> allowed him to <u>confess that</u> to <u>God</u>

& **the word** - **iniquity** means **GUILT** - & to **BLOT OUT** his **guilt** is to **REMOVE** it from the **Legal Record**

David has been CRYING OUT to be CLEANSED from his SIN

But more importantly - in v.10 - David cries out for God - to create in him a Clean Heart & Renew in him a Right Spirit

Psalm 51:10 (ESV)

10 Create in me a clean heart, O God, and renew a right spirit within me.

Brokenness is what **LEADS** us to Make **THIS CRY** to God

God, Please FORGIVE me of my sin

- & please **Create** in me a **CLEAN** Heart,
- & Renew RIGHT (steadfast, loyal) spirit within me

It is **Brokenness** that gets us to this **place** . . .

WHERE we recognize our life & death NEED for:

- 1) **FORGIVENESS** of our Sin
- 2) And for God to **CREATE** a **CLEAN HEART** in us
- 3) And **RENEW** a **RIGHT SPIRIT** in us
- & <u>make a note</u> of this the <u>Hebrew word</u> for <u>CREATE</u> (in me a clean heart) that is the <u>famous</u> word <u>BA-RA</u>

Which means "To Create Out of Nothing"

Brokenness causes us to CRY OUT to God - To Create in us a Clean Heart & Renew in us a Right Spirit

in v.11 - Brokenness brings an earnest desire for what is MOST important in our lives

Brokenness clears the fog of wrong thinking - & allows us to see

Truly Lord, what I need is YOU - Personally - I need your PRESENCE Lord - I need YOU with me

Psalm 51:11 (ESV)

11 Cast me not away from your presence, and take not your Holy Spirit from me.

The **most wonderful** & **joyful time** for a Christian - is to **sense** the "**Tangible" Presence** of **God**

To **know** that you are **Really**, **Truly** in His **Presence** & to **know** His **Holy Spirit** is **strengthening** you

To know GOD is:

the wind in your sails - the foundation beneath your feet, your Guide - Source - Provision - Safety - & Peace

ALL that God <u>IS</u> to you - <u>comes IN</u> His <u>PRESENCE</u> & it <u>comes <u>THRU</u> His Holy <u>Spirit</u></u>

<u>was</u> to be <u>BACK</u> in God's <u>PRESENCE</u> - with the **Holy Spirit Falling** Upon him **Again**

& David KNEW that his <u>Prideful</u>- <u>Unrepentant sin</u> - had <u>separated</u> him from the <u>Presence of God</u> - & from <u>God's Holy Spirit</u>

David Knew - what Isaiah later wrote in Isaiah 59:1-2 (NLT)

1 Listen! The Lord's arm is not too weak to save you, nor is his ear too deaf to hear you call.

2 It's your sins that have cut you off from God. Because of your sins, he has turned away and will not listen anymore.

<u>UN-Confessed</u> & <u>UN-repented</u> <u>Sin</u> - <u>Separates you</u> from God's <u>Presence</u>

<u>Sometimes</u> we think (in our Pride)
God has just <u>ARBITRARILY</u> turned away from us

BUT - **ISA 59:1-2** says that is **NOT** what has **happened**

Brokenness allows us to:

SEE our own sin

CONFESS it to God - & **REPENT** of it

& Be **RESTORED** to God's **Presence** - & **Power** of His **Holy Spirit**

THAT is why we call it - "The BLESSING of Brokenness"

& in v.12 - Brokenness brings a Fresh JOY of our Salvation

Psalm 51:12 (ESV)

12 Restore to me the joy of your salvation, and uphold me with a willing spirit.

We <u>tend to think</u> we need <u>THIS</u> from <u>God</u> - or <u>THAT</u> From <u>God</u> - Even <u>questioning God</u> if He <u>doesn't give us</u> what we expect

But **Brokenness FIXES** all that

Brokenness brings us back - to being JOYFUL that we're SAVED

God I'm just so thankful that you <u>saved</u> me, <u>adopted</u> me, & are <u>caring</u> for me - <u>thank you</u> for that <u>joy</u>, Lord

David <u>didn't LOSE</u> His <u>Salvation</u> - He lost the <u>JOY of his Salvation</u> & <u>you & I</u> can <u>easily</u> do the <u>same thing</u>

- & the #1 culprit for LOSING the JOY of our Salvation IS Sin in our lives Covered Up by the Pride in our hearts
- & <u>That Sin</u> <u>Covered up</u> by that <u>PRIDE</u> <u>Causes</u> us to <u>LOSE</u> the <u>Joy</u> of our <u>Salvation</u>

Brokenness causes us to PRAY - Lord, Restore me to the JOY of your Salvation . . . and uphold me with a willing spirit,

Meaning - Give me a <u>WILLING Spirit</u> to do <u>what's right</u> before you - to <u>OBEY</u> you, to be in <u>RIGHT Fellowship</u> with you

Then . . . Then . . . Then . . .

THEN - I can get Back in the Hunt -

THEN - I can get Back in the Battle -

THEN - I can get back to SERVING you . . .

Psalm 51:13 (ESV)

13 <u>Then</u> I will teach transgressors your ways, and sinners will return to you.

Brokenness brings a <u>fresh JOY</u> of just <u>BEING</u> in the <u>Service</u> of the <u>Lord</u>

Bring me back Lord, make my heart right
then I'll be able to be used by you again - for your Glory

THEN I can teach transgressors your ways, & sinners will return to you

Lord, I can't be used by you in my PRIDE I can't be used by you if I'm Harboring Sin in my heart

& so Lord, I come in Brokenness - desiring to be made RIGHT
So I can get back into the battle for souls So I can be used by you again, Lord

Brokenness gets us BACK into the Service of the Lord

<u>In v.14-15</u> - <u>Brokenness</u> brings us into <u>True Praise & Worship</u>

Psalm 51:14-15 (ESV)

14 Deliver me from bloodguiltiness, O God, O God of my salvation, and my tongue will sing aloud of your righteousness.
15 O Lord, open my lips, and my mouth will declare your praise.

Charles Spurgeon said:

"A great sinner pardoned, makes a great singer"

& man - that is the truth

You can **EASILY SEE** - A **Direct connection** between **BROKENNESS** and **WORSHIP**

Broken people WORSHIP GOD -

For WHO He IS - & WHAT He's DONE for them

I don't mean how EXPRESSIVE or NON-EXPRESSIVE they are I mean - WHETHER or NOT they're Worshipping, in any way . . .

It's very hard for a Person LOCKED UP in Pride - to really WORSHIP

Brokenness FIXES this problem

Coming to God as a Sinner Saved by His Grace & Mercy ALONE Un-Worthy & Un-Deserving.

Yet **coming boldly** to **worship Him** for **ALL He's done** for us

Brokenness brings us into True Praise & Worship

& then finally - in vs's 16-17 - are the famous SUMMARY Vs's of Brokenness

Psalm 51:16-17 (ESV)

16 For you will not delight in sacrifice, or I would give it; you will not be pleased with a burnt offering.

17 The sacrifices of God are a broken spirit; a broken and contrite heart, O God, you will not despise.

There was nothing David could "DO" to make himself "Right" w/ God

Nothing in the Law - NO Sacrifice - NO Offering could ATONE for his sin

& <u>David realized</u> - those "<u>ACTIONS</u>" (in & of themselves) <u>aren't really</u> what God <u>wants</u> - Anyway

The <u>TRUE Sacrifice</u> to be <u>Given to God</u> - is the <u>Sacrifice</u> of a <u>BROKEN SPIRIT</u> (opposite of Prideful spirit)

A Broken & Contrite Heart - God will NOT Despise

God will NOT Reject a Broken & Repentant Heart

God WILL, & DOES REJECT Just Going thru the MOTIONS of Religious Offerings

But <u>God</u> will <u>NEVER Reject</u> a <u>Truly Broken</u>, <u>Contrite</u>, <u>Repentant</u> Heart

If **YOU come** to Him with **THAT heart**He will **NEVER reject you** - **NEVER**

What God wanted from David - Was his Heart - Broken & Contrite over his Sin

God wanted David to be BROKEN BY his SIN
So he could be Restored to the JOY of his Salvation

That was What God wanted - That is ALL God EVER Wants
From every ONE of us - who are just as big a sinners as David

God doesn't want you 'Going thru the MOTIONS" - God wants your HEART

God wants us **BROKEN** over the **SIN** & **Spiritual Apathy** in our Lives

& then - MOURNING that Condition

God wants us to Humbly & Passionately seek His Mercy & Grace - to REVIVE us & RESTORE us - to the JOY of our Salvation

THAT is - The Blessing of Brokenness
