Bait02 - What Do You Expect? - Luke 6:27-49

In our <u>recent</u> study of <u>MARK</u> – <u>WHEN</u> we got to the <u>Crucifixion</u> - I <u>EXPECTED</u> <u>So MUCH MORE</u> from the <u>Disciples</u>

I couldn't believe they so easily DESERTED Jesus

I <u>couldn't believe</u> they <u>wouldn't</u> even <u>STAND UP</u> for Jesus in his greatest hour of Need

I <u>couldn't believe</u> that <u>instead</u> <u>being THERE</u> for Jesus They ALL <u>RAN</u> & <u>HID</u> – like a <u>bunch of cowards</u>

Peter **DENIED** – **3 Times** - that he **even KNEW** Jesus

I EXPECTED so MUCH MORE - From the Disciples

But . . . Jesus DID NOT

<u>Yes</u> – <u>Jesus</u> <u>WAS</u> <u>God</u> so he <u>KNEW</u> the END - <u>from</u> the <u>BEGINNING</u>

But <u>STILL</u> – Jesus <u>DID NOT EXPECT</u> *anything* From the <u>disciples</u> – <u>EVEN</u> as he <u>FACED</u> the <u>Cross</u>

Jesus <u>LOVED them</u> - & he <u>FORGAVE them</u> & he <u>DIED for them</u>

With *NO Expectations* regarding their **BEHAVIOR**

Their ACTIONS - & their FAILURES - DIDN'T CHANGE - At All

The <u>LOVE</u> - - & The <u>FORGIVENESS</u> - - & The <u>SACRIFICE</u> that <u>Jesus</u> made for <u>EACH</u> of them

Jesus LOVED & FORGAVE – Those CLOSEST to him

In the **SAME WAY** he did - the **Centurion** who **oversaw** his **death**

What do <u>YOU EXPECT</u> From those closest to <u>YOU?</u>

Let's Pray

<u>Last week</u> – we <u>STARTED</u> a <u>New Series</u> called The <u>BAIT of SATAN</u>

& IEXPLAINED - In my 30 years in Church Leadership

<u>BY FAR</u> the most <u>Productive BAIT</u> <u>I've seen</u> the <u>enemy use</u> to <u>ENTRAP Christians</u>

Is the **BAIT of OFFENSE**

BUT - I explained - The OFFENSE - is ONLY the BAIT

When <u>YOU</u> take the <u>BAIT of OFFENSE</u> & <u>BECOME OFFENDED</u>

THAT is when the enemy (so often) ENTRAPS YOU

A <u>person</u> OFFENDS YOU – (*Especially* IN the *Church*) – <u>THAT is The BAIT</u>

When You <u>Take UP</u> that <u>OFFENSE</u> - & <u>BECOME OFFENDED</u> <u>THAT is the TRAP</u>

& <u>WHEN</u> the Enemy <u>ENTRAPS US</u> – <u>By getting us</u> to <u>BECOME OFFENDED</u>

(especially by someone in the church)

We <u>often</u> spend <u>years</u> (or <u>even</u> a <u>lifetime</u>) <u>PRODUCING</u> - the <u>Works of the Flesh</u>

Which the Enemy USES

to *Damage* – or *Destroy* - Other <u>Christians</u> & <u>Entire Churches</u>

<u>BUT</u> – these msgs <u>BUILD</u> on <u>One-Another</u> - As we <u>LOOSELY</u> follow the Book "<u>The BAIT of SATAN</u>" by <u>John Bever</u>

& <u>So</u> – <u>You</u> really <u>NEED to Watch</u>, <u>Listen</u>, or <u>READ</u> the <u>FIRST Msg</u> - along with <u>THIS MSG</u>

If you <u>MISSED</u> the <u>First MSG</u> (called <u>The Bait of Satan</u>) You can <u>Get it</u> on the "<u>Word By Mail</u>" <u>Phone App</u>

<u>So – BACK to Today's Focus</u>

What <u>DID</u> you <u>EXPECT</u> from <u>that Person</u> who <u>Offended</u> You?

What did you EXPECT from them?

Doesn't it sound RIGHT for us to say,

"Well, I <u>expected</u> them to <u>act</u> like a <u>Christian</u>, I <u>expected</u> them to <u>do</u> what was <u>RIGHT</u> - - What <u>I thought</u> was <u>RIGHT</u>!"

Really? & what do you EXPECT of YOURSELF?

<u>Do</u> you expect <u>YOURSELF</u> to <u>ACT</u> like a <u>CHRISTIAN</u>? Do you expect <u>YOURSELF</u> to <u>DO</u> what is <u>RIGHT</u>?

Let's turn over to Luke Ch 6 - & Let's ask "Do I expect MYSELF to ACT like a Christian?"

Luke 6:27–28 (NLT)

27 *"But to you who are <u>willing</u> to <u>listen</u>, (have you ever met a Christian who is NOT willing to listen?) <i>I say, <u>love your enemies</u>!* (those you think are your enemies – inside the church) <u>*Do good*</u> to those who <u>hate you</u>. (those you think hate you – inside the church)

28 <u>**Bless those</u> who <u>curse</u> you. (those you think are cursing you – inside the church) <u>Pray</u> for those who <u>hurt</u> you.</u> (those you think are hurting you – inside the church)</u>**</u>

Is <u>THIS</u> how we <u>Expect OURSELVES</u> to <u>ACT?</u>

& then (just down) - Luke 6:32-33 (NLT)

32 "If you <u>love only</u> those who <u>love you</u>, (inside the church) why should you get credit for that? <u>Even sinners</u> love those who love them! (outside the church) 33 And if you <u>do good only</u> to those who <u>do good to you</u>, (inside the church) why should you get credit? <u>Even sinners</u> do that *much!* (outside the church)

Do these vs's make sense to us?

<u>Isn't</u> it <u>WRONG</u> – that <u>IN the CHURCH</u> <u>Far Too Often</u> – We <u>IGNORE</u> these <u>Biblical Commands</u>

When we are dealing with OTHER Christians

Especially other <u>Christians</u> - who have <u>Offended us</u> Or <u>even</u> who <u>rub</u> us (A <u>little bit</u>) the <u>WRONG way</u>

Guys - <u>FAR Too Often</u> – <u>We Use</u> the <u>WORLD'S Standards</u>

To <u>decide</u> who <u>WE LOVE</u> - & who we will <u>DO GOOD TO</u><u>INSIDE the CHURCH</u>

- & <u>WORSE</u> <u>FAR Too Often</u> <u>We Use</u> the <u>WORLD'S Standards</u>
- to <u>Justify</u> our <u>RESPONSE to people</u> who <u>have hurt</u> - or <u>offended us?</u>
- & *FAR, FAR Too Often* . . . Our *NATURAL Response* to **those** who have **Offended us**

Is the **SAME** *NATURAL Response* – **<u>AS UNBELIEVERS</u>**

& - Jesus goes on - Luke 6:35-36 (NLT)

35 "Love your enemies! (or those you think are your enemies – inside the church) **Do good to them.** (do what is good FOR them – inside the church) **Lend to them without expecting to be repaid. Then your reward <u>from</u> heaven will be very great, and <u>you will</u> <u>truly be acting as children of the Most High</u>, (isn't <u>THIS</u> what we should <u>Expect</u> of <u>ourselves</u> as <u>Christians</u>?) for he** (The <u>Most High</u>) **is** <u>kind</u> to those who are <u>unthankful</u> and <u>wicked</u>. (in the <u>church</u>)

36 You must be compassionate, <u>just as</u> (in the same way as) **your Father is compassionate**.

<u>Seriously</u> – We <u>could LIVE</u> in these <u>vs's</u> <u>FOREVER</u> Couldn't we?

& <u>then</u> in the <u>next Vs</u> (starting a new section) <u>Jesus</u> just <u>keeps rolling</u>

Luke 6:37 (NLT)

37 "Do not judge others (in the church) (Lstn Pls, here, this word means "to form a critical opinion of another") (do not form a critical opinion of another person – in the church) (how many of us specialize in forming critical opinions of others?), and you will not be judged. Do not <u>condemn</u> others (in the church) (to condemn, is to pronounce someone worthy of punishment) (how often do we pronounce someone worthy of some type of punishment in the church?), or it will all come back against you. Forgive others (in the church), and you will be forgiven.

These are <u>Serious</u>, <u>Serious Warnings</u> To <u>NOT Take</u> the <u>BAIT of SATAN</u> – <u>IN the church</u> In <u>LUKE Ch 6</u> - Jesus <u>goes on</u> about <u>THIS Same Subject</u> From <u>v.27</u> – <u>all</u> the <u>way</u> to <u>v.49</u> (end of the ch)

This <u>would</u> be an <u>awesome section</u> for us to <u>Meditate on</u> <u>every day</u> - for a <u>WEEK</u> - or a <u>MONTH</u> - or a <u>YEAR</u>!

AND ever day – APPLY it – TO OURSELVES

By Simply ASKING OURSELVES

"Do I EXPECT MYSELF to act this way (as a Christian)"

If <u>we</u> were to <u>Genuinely APPLY</u> – the <u>MANY Vs's</u> in the <u>N.T.</u> – <u>on this Subject</u>

I think we MAY Learn To NOT EXPECT PERFECTION Of OTHERS While Giving OURSELVES – a HUGE PASS on our Own Actions

& we <u>MAY LEARN</u> To <u>NOT</u> - SO <u>EASILY</u> – <u>TAKE</u> the <u>BAIT of SATAN</u>

<u>Because</u> guys - <u>Most often</u> – <u>THIS</u> is <u>NOT</u> the <u>type of LOVE</u> we <u>Walk In</u> – <u>IS IT?</u>

- & <u>isn't there</u> a <u>chance</u> that <u>at least</u> <u>PART</u> of the <u>Reason</u> - we <u>DON'T walk</u> in this <u>Love</u>
- is **because BEING OFFENDED** has **Become the NORM** in **Church**?

- & <u>NOT Just</u> the <u>NORM in Church</u> But <u>FULLY ACCEPTED</u> by other <u>Christians</u>
- & **NOT Just** *FULLY ACCEPTED* by other **Christians** But **SUPPORTED & ENCOURAGED** by other **Christians**

They did <u>WHAAAT</u> to you?

The <u>people</u> <u>God</u> put in <u>charge</u> of <u>LEADING</u> the <u>CHURCH</u> made a Leadership <u>DECISION</u> about the <u>Church</u> . . . <u>HOW COULD THEY</u>

You <u>should</u> be <u>SO OFFENDED</u> By that

<u>That person did WHAAAT</u> to you? <u>They Did</u>? Oh <u>Honey</u>, tell me <u>more</u> – <u>ALL</u> the <u>Gory Details</u>

Oh, I <u>can't believe</u> it – I am <u>SO with you</u> <u>We</u> have <u>got</u> to <u>DO SOMETHING</u> about <u>this</u>!

Listen – <u>IN REGARD</u> – to <u>Other People</u> <u>Feeding your OFFENSE</u>

Can I show you a <u>HARD APPLICATION</u> to a <u>WELL-KNOWN</u> <u>Scripture</u>

Turn over to Matthew 7:15

<u>Matthew 7:15 \rightarrow \rightarrow </u>

Matthew 7:15-17, 20 (NLT)

15 "Beware of false prophets who come disguised as harmless sheep but are really vicious wolves.

16 You can identify them by their fruit, that is, by the way they act. Can you pick grapes from thornbushes, or figs from thistles? 17 A good tree produces good fruit, and a bad tree produces bad fruit.

. . .

20 Yes, just as you can identify a tree by its fruit, so you can identify people by their actions.

<u>Can I say</u> – <u>GENTLY</u>, <u>Please</u>

If <u>you</u> are <u>offended</u> – & <u>a person</u> <u>comes</u> <u>alongside</u> you & <u>FANS</u> the <u>FLAME</u> of your <u>OFFENSE</u>

<u>That person</u> – I think <u>can be</u> accurately <u>described</u> as a <u>False Prophet</u> (teacher) in <u>your life</u>

IF they are FANNING the FLAMES – of Your FLESH & if they are FEEDING your OFFENSE

Then <u>They</u> are <u>PRODUCING BAD FRUIT</u> <u>In YOUR LIFE</u>

When You have taken the BAIT of SATAN

& **you** have **BECOME OFFENDED** <u>Especially</u> By <u>another believer</u> in the church

WHAT TYPE of Prophet (Counselor) do you need?

You need one who will TELL YOU The TRUTH

<u>NOT their Opinion</u> -& <u>NOT Agree</u> with <u>YOUR Opinion</u>

But **Someone** Who **will Tell you**

The <u>ONLY Truth</u> - <u>we</u> are <u>Called</u> to <u>RUN our Lives</u> <u>BY</u> The <u>TRUTH</u> of the <u>Word of God</u>

We <u>don't need</u> – a <u>Wolf</u> in <u>Sheep's Clothing</u> <u>FEEDING</u> the <u>FLAMES</u> of <u>OFFENSE</u> in our <u>Lives</u>

We <u>need someone</u> to <u>Lovingly SPEAK</u> the <u>Word of God</u> to us

We **need someone** to **SHOW** us – **BY God's Word**

That <u>WE</u> have <u>TAKEN</u> the <u>BAIT of SATAN</u> By <u>BECOMING OFFENDED</u>

& <u>that it</u> is <u>OUR HEART</u> that <u>must</u> be <u>dealt with</u> - <u>FIRST</u>

NOT the person who has Offended Us

<u>Now</u> – <u>IF</u> the <u>person</u> who <u>has offended</u> us - <u>HAS SINNED</u>

Then – God's Word gives us ways to Address that Sin

For Example – Matthew 18:21–22 (NLT)

21 Then Peter came to him and asked, "Lord, how often should I forgive someone who sins against me? Seven times?" 22 "No, not seven times," Jesus replied, "but seventy times seven!

So – <u>God's Word</u> <u>DOES</u> give us <u>clear instruction</u> <u>LIKE</u> these <u>vs's</u>

About HOW to deal with someone who has sinned against us

But FIRST - we MUST Understand

That if we have this FIRE of OFFENSE living inside us

<u>Whether</u> it's a <u>SMOLDERING EMBER</u> Or a <u>RAGING INFERNO</u>

<u>Then</u> we <u>MUST</u>, <u>FIRST</u> <u>Deal</u> with <u>OUR OWN HEART</u>

We <u>have GOT</u> to <u>DROP</u> that <u>BAIT of SATAN</u>

& <u>GET FREE</u> of the <u>Enemy's</u> <u>TRAP of OFFENSE</u> Can we do just One More Scripture before we go?

<u>Galatians 6:7–8 (NLT)</u> 7 Don't be misled—you cannot mock the justice of God. <u>You will</u> <u>always harvest what you plant</u>.

8 Those who live only to <u>satisfy their own sinful nature</u> (that's what we naturally do when we become offended) will harvest <u>decay</u> and <u>death from</u> that <u>sinful nature</u>. But those who live to <u>please the</u> <u>Spirit</u> (which is opposite of what we naturally do) will <u>harvest</u> <u>everlasting life</u> from the Spirit.

<u>When</u> we are <u>TEMPTED</u> to <u>TAKE</u> the <u>BAIT of SATAN</u> - & <u>BECOME OFFENDED</u>

We MUST Ask ourselves

Do I WANT to Harvest Decay & Death from My Sin Nature - In this situation

<u>OR</u> – <u>Do I WANT</u> to <u>Harvest</u> <u>Everlasting Life</u> from <u>The Spirit</u> - <u>In this situation</u>

In other <u>words</u> – we <u>have</u> to be <u>very careful</u> <u>HOW we respond</u>

When we are FACED - with this BAIT of SATAN

AND - the LAST person - we NEED in our LIVES at that moment

Is a **person who** is - **AGREEING** with **OUR Sin Nature**

& <u>Encouraging</u> us to <u>Harvest</u> <u>Decay & Death</u> <u>From this situation</u>

<u>So – continuing in Galatians 6:9-10 (NLT)</u>

9 So let's <u>not get tired</u> of doing what is good (love in action). At just the right time we will reap a harvest of blessing if we <u>don't</u> <u>give up</u>.

10 Therefore, whenever we have the opportunity (like when we are tempted to become offended), we should <u>do good</u> (love in action) to everyone—<u>especially</u> to those in the <u>family of faith</u>.

<u>WHY</u> are we <u>SO QUICK</u> to <u>Take-Up</u> "<u>Being Offended</u>" by <u>those</u> in the <u>Family of Faith</u>

& <u>SO SLOW</u> – *to FORGIVE* those in the **Family of Faith**

MAYBE – Because we are TAKING the BAIT of SATAN

So – <u>What</u> I'd <u>like</u> to do Is <u>PRAY right now</u>

But <u>then</u> I'd like to <u>**READ THRU**</u> the <u>hand-out</u> we <u>passed out</u> as you <u>came in</u> this <u>morning</u> - (everyone have one?)

Let's Pray

Adapted from "The Bait of Satan" John Bevere, chapter 2

God's love in my life will not be conditioned upon my expectations or the actions of those around me. With the Holy Spirit's help, I will love those who have offended me. (1Pet 4:8)

I commit to allowing the agape love of God, which has been poured out in my heart, to flow to those who have offended me. (Rom 5:5)

I refuse to live according to my flesh, instead I choose to live according to the Spirit in all my dealings with those who have offended me. (Gal 6:7-8)

Holy Spirit, please give me the strength to not grow tired of doing good and truly loving those who have offended me or not met my expectations. (Gal 6:9-10)

With God's power I will tear down every stronghold of human reasoning that causes me to take the bait of offense. (2Cor 10:4-5)

I will live with an open heart of love and will not become imprisoned by my own walls of conditional expectations. (Prov 18:19)

I will follow the admonition of Jesus to love my enemies, do good to those who hate me, bless those who curse me, and pray for those who hurt me. (Luke 6:27-28)

I will never deny the power of Godliness at work in my life. I will allow God's truth to pierce my heart and bring forth the character of Jesus Christ in me. (2Tim 3:3-5)

Many around me are living with offense toward others, I refuse to listen to them or join them in their sin. I will guard my heart against those who speak only what I want to hear, not what I need to hear. (Mat 7:15-20)
